CLIENT STATES THE FA WANTED AN IN-PERSON VISIT AT THE FINANCIAL ADVISOR'S OFFICE AT THE FINANCIAL ADVISOR'S CONVENIENCE. CLIENT INDICATES, ALTHOUGH THE FINANCIAL ADVISOR HAS STATED TO THE CONTRARY, HE UNDERSTANDS VERBAL INSTRUCTIONS ARE COMMON THROUGHOUT EDWARD JONES OFFICES. CLIENT ALLEGES, AT THE TIME OF HIS REQUEST, THE VALUE OF THE INVESTMENTS HELD IN HIS ACCOUNT WAS APPROXIMATELY \$265,000.00. AS SUCH, HE IS REQUESTING A SETTLEMENT OF \$15,000.00. FILING REQUIRED.

THE CLIENT HAS ALLEGED HE SPOKE WITH THE FA IN NOVEMBER AND DECEMBER 2010 AT WHICH TIME HE PROVIDED INSTRUCTIONS TO LIQUIDATE THE INVESTMENTS HELD IN THE ACCOUNT. HOWEVER, THE CLIENT HAS PROVIDED NO SPECIFIC DATE AS TO WHEN THOSE INSTRUCTIONS WERE PURPORTEDLY PROVIDED TO THE FA. ALTHOUGH THE FA DOES NOT RECALL EXACT DETAILS OF CONVERSATIONS WITH THE CLIENT, HE HAS INDICATED HE WOULD NOT TELL ANY CLIENT THAT HE COULD NOT ACCEPT INSTRUCTIONS VIA TELEPHONE. ACCORDING TO OUR RECORDS, THE INVESTMENTS HELD IN THE ACCOUNT WERE LIQUIDATED ON DECEMBER 15, 2010. AT THE TIME OF THE LIQUIDATIONS, THE CLIENT WOULD HAVE RECEIVED TRADE CONFIRMATIONS. IN ADDITION, THE LIQUIDATIONS WERE REFLECTED ON THE DECEMBER 2010



ACCOUNT STATEMENTS. OUR RECORDS REFLECT THE PROCEEDS FROM THE LIQUIDATIONS WERE DISBURSED FROM THE ACCOUNT AS FOLLOWS: 1) A CHECK IN THE AMOUNT OF \$125,000.00 PAYABLE TO THE CLIENT AND MAILED TO THE ADDRESS OF RECORD AND 2) A TRANSFER OF \$125,300.98 TO ANOTHER EDWARD JONES (ADVISORY SOLUTIONS) ACCOUNT. THE ADVISORY SOLUTIONS ACCOUNT WAS TRANSFERRED TO FINANCIAL ADVISOR MATTHEW BURNETT ON JANUARY 25, 2012. THE TRANSACTIONS WERE EVIDENCED THROUGH TRADE CONFIRMATIONS AND ACCOUNT STATEMENTS. IF THERE WERE ANY ISSUES ASSOCIATED WITH TRANSACTIONS COMPLETED IN DECEMBER 2010, IT SEEMS THIS SITUATION WOULD HAVE BEEN BROUGHT TO OUR ATTENTION IN A TIMELIER MANNER. CLAIM DENIED.

THE PRIMARY CONCERN SEEMS TO BE THE FINANCIAL ADVISOR PROVIDED POOR ADVICE OR NO ADVICE WITH REGARD TO THE CLIENT'S MUTUAL FUNDS AND ANNUITY. THE OTHER ISSUES RAISED APPEAR TO BE SERVICE RELATED CONCERNS. THE CLIENT BELIEVES \$10,000 WOULD BE A REASONABLE AMOUNT TO BE REIMBURSED.

THE FINANCIAL ADVISOR STATED THAT THE CLIENT WAS ACTIVELY INVOLVED IN CHOOSING THE FUNDS IN WHICH TO INVEST. THE FINANCIAL ADVISOR STATED THAT HE ADVISE THE CLIENT TO CONSIDER VARIOUS ASPECTS OF AN INVESTMENT BEFORE MAKING A DECISION TO INVEST. THE FINANCIAL ADVISOR ALSO RECALLED THAT IT WAS EXPRESSED TO THE CLIENT THAT WASHINGTON MUTUAL WAS NOT ONE OF THE FUNDS HE OFTEN HIGHLY RECOMMENDED WHEN DOING PORTFOLIO PROPOSALS, HOWEVER, THAT WAS THE EXTENT OF HIS COMMENTS REGARDING THE FUND AT THAT TIME. THE FINANCIAL ADVISOR STATED THAT INVESTMENT OPTIONS FOR THE SUB ACCOUNTS FOR THE ANNUITY



WERE DISCUSSED IN DETAIL. IT WAS NOT INDICATED THAT THE CLIENT COULD NOT CHOOSE THE FUNDS, HOWEVER, IT WAS RECOMMENDED TO GO WITH THE EDWARD JONES' RECOMMENDED PORTFOLIO AS ONE OPTION. THE FINANCIAL ADVISOR STATED THAT THE SURRENDER VALUE OF THE ANNUITY WAS DISCUSSED IN DETAIL AND THE CLIENT CLEARLY UNDERSTOOD THAT IF THE POLICY WAS SURRENDERED THE VALUE WOULD BE BASED ON THE SUB ACCOUNT PERFORMANCE VALUE. AS WAS DISCUSSED WITH THE CLIENT, THIS WAS AN A SHARE ANNUITY SO SURRENDER CHARGES WOULD NOT APPLY. SEVERAL ADDITIONAL SERVICE-RELATED ISSUES WERE ALSO ADDRESSED TO THE CLIENT. IT APPEARS AS THOUGH THE MATTERS MENTIONED IN THE CLIENT'S LETTER WERE NOT HANDLED IMPROPERLY. AS SUCH THERE WILL BE NO ADJUSTMENT AT THIS TIME.
