IAPD Information About Representatives

IAPD offers information on all current-and many former representatives. Investors are strongly encouraged to use IAPD to check the background of representatives before deciding to conduct, or continue to conduct, business with them.

What is included in a IAPD report?

IAPD reports for individual representatives include information such as employment history, professional qualifications, disciplinary actions, criminal convictions, civil judgments and arbitration awards.

It is important to note that the information contained in an IAPD report may include pending actions or allegations that may be contested, unresolved or unproven. In the end, these actions or allegations may be resolved in favor of the representative, or concluded through a negotiated settlement with no admission or finding of wrongdoing.

Where did this information come from?

The information contained in IAPD comes from the Investment Adviser Registration Depository (IARD) and FINRA's Central Registration Depository, or CRD, (see more on CRD below) and is a combination of:

- information the states require representatives and firms to submit as part of the registration and licensing process, and
- information that state regulators report regarding disciplinary actions or allegations against representatives.

How current is this information?

Generally, representatives are required to update their professional and disciplinary information in IARD within 30 days.

Allegations: 12/05-9/08; THE CLIENT STATES THE INVESTMENTS THE FA RECOMMENDED WOULD GENERATE INTEREST. SHE STATES SHE TOLD THE FA SHE NEEDED \$750 IN MONTHLY EXPENSES; SHE STATES SHE TOLD HIM IT SHOULD NOT COME OUT OF THE INVESTMENTS. SHE STATES SHE LATER WITHDREW \$30000 FROM HER ACCOUNT TO PUT A DOWN PAYMENT ON A HOUSE. SHE STATES THE FA DID NOT INFORM HER THIS COULD BE TAXABLE. SHE STATES THE VALUE OF THE ACCOUNT DECLINED; WHEN SHE QUESTIONED THE FA HE SAID IT WAS DUE TO THE ECONOMY. SHE STATES SHE WAS NOT IN THE STOCK MARKET SO SHE SHOULD NOT HAVE ANY LOSSES. SHE STATES HE THEN RECOMMENDED TWO BONDS TO HELP GENERATE MORE INTEREST - GE PAYING 5% EVERY 6 MONTHS AND A CITIGROUP PAYING 6%. SHE STATES THE FA TOLD HER THESE WERE GOOD INVESTMENTS; SHE STATES SHE LOST MONEY ON THOSE INVESTMENTS. SHE STATES SHE WANTED TO INCREASE HER MONTHLY INCOME BY AN ADDITIONAL \$300. SHE STATES SHORTLY AFTER THE INCREASE SHE REALIZED HER MONTHLY INCOME WAS BEING TAKEN FROM HER INVESTMENTS. SHE STATES SHORTLY AFTER THAT, SHE REQUESTED TO LIQUIDATE HER ACCOUNTS. SHE STATES SHE LOST APPROXIMATELY \$40,000 DUE TO THE FA'S RECOMMENDATIONS AND MANAGEMENT OF THE ACCOUNTS; SHE WOULD LIKE TO BE REIMBURSED.

THE CLIENT DEPOSITED \$203,910.14 ON 12/15/05. BEGINNING IN JANUARY 2006, THE CLIENT BEGAN MAKING MONTHLY WITHDRAWALS OF \$750. IN ADDITION THE CLIENT MADE TWO ADDITIONAL WITHDRAWALS IN 2006 TOTALING \$50,400; THE TOTAL AMOUNT WITHDRAWN FROM 2006 WAS \$59,400. IN 2007, THE CLIENT WITHDREW A TOTAL OF \$12,000 BY TAKING \$1000 A MONTH FROM THE ACCOUNT. THE CLIENT CONTINUED TAKING \$1000 A MONTH UNTIL SEPTEMBER 2008. THE CLIENT MADE ADDITIONAL WITHDRAWALS IN 2008 TOTALING \$10,729.64 AND A FINAL WITHDRAWAL OF \$117,199.02. IN ALL, THE CLIENT WITHDREW \$208,328.66. THERE WAS NOT A \$40,000 LOSS. THE FA STATES HE DID INFORM THE CLIENT THE WITHDRAWALS WERE COME FROM THE PRINCIPAL AMOUNT AND INTEREST FROM THE CDS. HE STATES HE ALSO INFORMED THE CLIENT THAT ANY WITHDRAWALS MADE COULD BE TREATED AS TAXABLE INCOME. WHILE WE UNDERSTAND THE CLIENT'S DISAPPOINTMENT IN THE VALUE OF THE BONDS GE AND CITIGROUP, THE VALUES ARE AFFECTED BY CIRCUMSTANCES BEYOND OUR CONTROL AND MARKET FLUCTUATION, WHICH IS A RISK ASSOCIATED IN INVESTING. AT THE TIME OF THE PURCHASES, THE BONDS MET THE CLIENT'S STATED OBJECTIVE OF INCOME. THE CLIENT'S REQUEST FOR REIMBURSEMENT IS RESPECTFULLY DENIED.
