IAPD Information About Representatives

IAPD offers information on all current-and many former representatives. Investors are strongly encouraged to use IAPD to check the background of representatives before deciding to conduct, or continue to conduct, business with them.

What is included in a IAPD report?

IAPD reports for individual representatives include information such as employment history, professional qualifications, disciplinary actions, criminal convictions, civil judgments and arbitration awards.

It is important to note that the information contained in an IAPD report may include pending actions or allegations that may be contested, unresolved or unproven. In the end, these actions or allegations may be resolved in favor of the representative, or concluded through a negotiated settlement with no admission or finding of wrongdoing.

Where did this information come from?

The information contained in IAPD comes from the Investment Adviser Registration Depository (IARD) and FINRA's Central Registration Depository, or CRD, (see more on CRD below) and is a combination of:

- information the states require representatives and firms to submit as part of the registration and licensing process, and
- information that state regulators report regarding disciplinary actions or allegations against representatives.

How current is this information?

Generally, representatives are required to update their professional and disciplinary information in IARD within 30 days.

Regulator Statement

On August 5, 2022, the Office of Financial Regulation (Office) entered a Final Order adopting the Stipulation and Consent Agreement in the matter of Bianca Michelle Noiseux (Noiseux). Noiseux neither admitted nor denied the allegations but consented to the entry of findings by the Office. The Office found that Noiseux violated Section 517.12(4), Florida Statutes, by rendering investment advice, from a location within Florida, without being registered by the Office. Noiseux agreed to Cease and Desist from violations of Chapter 517, Florida Statutes, and the Administrative Rules adopted thereto, and to pay an administrative fine in the amount of \$10,000. The Office agreed to approve Noiseux's application as an associated person (RA) with William Joseph Capital Management, LLC effective August 5, 2022.

Broker Statement

When Ms. Noiseux began conducting investment advisory services remotely from her personal residence in Florida during the COVID-19 pandemic, she sought direction from the firm and from the experienced outside compliance consultant hired specifically for licensing paperwork and administrative filing. The consultant determined that IAR registration in the State of Florida was not necessary, and registered Ms. Noiseux only in Connecticut, where the home office of the firm is located. When asked numerous times, he stated that he confirmed his understanding in a phone call with the State of Florida. Ms. Noiseux and the firm relied on his advice over a two-year period.

In April 2022, the firm and Ms. Noiseux discovered that the advice we relied on was incorrect. The State of Florida agreed to register her if she signed a Stipulation and Consent Order and pay an administrative penalty.

It should be noted that since obtaining her first securities license in 1998, Ms. Noiseux has been fully compliant with all requirements of regulatory authorities and had maintained an unblemished record until this incident. When she relocated to Florida, she applied for her insurance license as required under Florida statute. Without admitting or denying the allegations from the State of Florida, Ms. Noiseux respects the conclusion of the State of Florida and appreciates their help in resolving the matter quickly. Ms. Noiseux has been approved by the State of Florida as an investment advisor representative of the firm and is in good standing.
