ON AUGUST 29, 2012, THE OFFICE OF HEARING OFFICERS RECEIVED A LETTER ADVISING THAT JONES DECLINED TO PARTICIPATE IN THE HEARING SCHEDULED FOR SEPTEMBER 5, 2012. THE HEARING WAS HELD, JONES DID NOT APPEAR AND THE DEPARTMENT OF ENFORCEMENT MOVED THAT THE CASE BE DISMISSED PURSUANT TO RULE 9559(M). THE MOTION WAS GRANTED. THE HEARING OFFICER FOUND THAT JONES ABANDONED HER DEFENSE AND DISMISSED THE PROCEEDING. THE NOTICE OF SUSPENSION DATED APRIL 10, 2012 WAS DEEMED FINRA'S FINAL ACTION. PURSUANT TO ARTICLE VI, SECTION 3 OF FINRA BY-LAWS AND FINRA RULE 9554, RESPONDENT JONES IS SUSPENDED FOR FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH AN ARBITRATION AWARD OR SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT OR TO SATISFACTORILY RESPOND TO A FINRA REQUEST TO PROVIDE INFORMATION CONCERNING THE STATUS OF COMPLIANCE. **Broker Statement**

WE VIEW IT AS GROSSLY UNFAIR THAT FINRA SUSPENDED OUR SECURITIES LICENSES BASED UPON AN AWARD THAT WAS OBTAINED BY AN ENTITY THAT WAS NEVER A FINRA MEMBER, NAMELY AUSTIN HATCH AND SMITH, LLC, DBA CHRISTOPHER STREET FINANCIAL, THE PURPORTED CLAIMANT IN THE ARBITRATION BEFORE NASD DISPUTE RESOLUTION ENTITLED AUSTIN HATCH AND SMITH, LLC, D/B/A CHRISTOPHER STREET FINANCIAL VS. SUSAN M. SIMON AND ELIZABETH A. JONES NO. 06-00492. FINRA DID NOT HAVE JURISDICTION TO ALLOW THE AFOREMENTIONED ARBITRATION TO PROCEED. WE WERE FORCED TO SETTLE THIS MATTER IN ORDER TO REINSTATE OUR LICENSES. UPON SUBMISSION OF WRITTEN SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT THE SUSPENSION OF OUR SECURITIES LICENSES WAS LIFTED.
