BCC AS A RESULT OF AN INVESTIGATION BY THE EXCHANGE'S STAFF, WHICH INDICATED THAT THERE WAS PROBABLE CAUSE FOR FINDING A VIOLATION WITHIN THE DISCIPLINARY JURISDICTION OF THE EXCHANGE. AN OFFER OF SETTLEMENT WAS SUBMITTED NEITHER ADMITTING NOR DENYING THE VIOLATIONS ALLEGED IN THE STATEMENT OF CHARGES.
