IAPD Information About Representatives

IAPD offers information on all current-and many former representatives. Investors are strongly encouraged to use IAPD to check the background of representatives before deciding to conduct, or continue to conduct, business with them.

What is included in a IAPD report?

IAPD reports for individual representatives include information such as employment history, professional qualifications, disciplinary actions, criminal convictions, civil judgments and arbitration awards.

It is important to note that the information contained in an IAPD report may include pending actions or allegations that may be contested, unresolved or unproven. In the end, these actions or allegations may be resolved in favor of the representative, or concluded through a negotiated settlement with no admission or finding of wrongdoing.

Where did this information come from?

The information contained in IAPD comes from the Investment Adviser Registration Depository (IARD) and FINRA's Central Registration Depository, or CRD, (see more on CRD below) and is a combination of:

- information the states require representatives and firms to submit as part of the registration and licensing process, and
- information that state regulators report regarding disciplinary actions or allegations against representatives.

How current is this information?

Generally, representatives are required to update their professional and disciplinary information in IARD within 30 days.

Regulator Statement

The Division alleges that Bonaccorsy violated Rule 21 VAC 5-80-100 by failing to make the appropriate Form U4 filing amendment in compliance with all of the requirements of CRD to disclose an unsatisfied Capital One Bank judgment entered by the District Court of Maryland for St. Mary's County on October 12, 2011. The disclosure of outstanding liens and judgments is required to be made on Form U4 pertaining to an individual's financial disclosure history. The Division alleges that Bonaccorsy did not make the necessary disclosure as he failed to file a Form U4 amendment in accordance with the above-referenced Rule. The Division assessed a monetary penalty of \$500.
