## IAPD Information About Representatives

IAPD offers information on all current-and many former representatives. Investors are strongly encouraged to use IAPD to check the background of representatives before deciding to conduct, or continue to conduct, business with them.

### What is included in a IAPD report?

IAPD reports for individual representatives include information such as employment history, professional qualifications, disciplinary actions, criminal convictions, civil judgments and arbitration awards.

It is important to note that the information contained in an IAPD report may include pending actions or allegations that may be contested, unresolved or unproven. In the end, these actions or allegations may be resolved in favor of the representative, or concluded through a negotiated settlement with no admission or finding of wrongdoing.

### Where did this information come from?

The information contained in IAPD comes from the Investment Adviser Registration Depository (IARD) and FINRA's Central Registration Depository, or CRD, (see more on CRD below) and is a combination of:

- information the states require representatives and firms to submit as part of the registration and licensing process, and
- information that state regulators report regarding disciplinary actions or allegations against representatives.

Generally, representatives are required to update their professional and disciplinary information in IARD within 30 days.

THE COMMISSION'S ORDER BARRED PRIMER FROM FUTURE ASSOCIATION WITH ANY BROKER, DEALER, INVESTMENT ADVISOR, INVESTMENT COMPANY OR MUNICIPAL SECURITIES DEALER. IT ALSO CENSURED THE FIRM AND ORDERED IT TO RETAIN AN INDEPENDENT CONSULTANT TO RECOMMEND POLICIES AND PROCEDURES WHICH THE FIRM WOULD ADOPT AND MAINTAIN, TO PROVIDE REASONABLE ASSURANCE AGAINST FUTURE VIOLATIONS OF FEDERAL SECURITIES LAWS, SPECIFICALLY THOSE CONCERNING RELATED PARTY TRANSACTIONS AND TRANSACTIONS IN SECURITIES WITH WHOSE ISSUERS THE FIRM AND ITS PRINCIPALS ARE AFFILIATED.
