IAPD Information About Representatives

IAPD offers information on all current-and many former representatives. Investors are strongly encouraged to use IAPD to check the background of representatives before deciding to conduct, or continue to conduct, business with them.

What is included in a IAPD report?

IAPD reports for individual representatives include information such as employment history, professional qualifications, disciplinary actions, criminal convictions, civil judgments and arbitration awards.

It is important to note that the information contained in an IAPD report may include pending actions or allegations that may be contested, unresolved or unproven. In the end, these actions or allegations may be resolved in favor of the representative, or concluded through a negotiated settlement with no admission or finding of wrongdoing.

Where did this information come from?

The information contained in IAPD comes from the Investment Adviser Registration Depository (IARD) and FINRA's Central Registration Depository, or CRD, (see more on CRD below) and is a combination of:

- information the states require representatives and firms to submit as part of the registration and licensing process, and
- information that state regulators report regarding disciplinary actions or allegations against representatives.

Generally, representatives are required to update their professional and disciplinary information in IARD within 30 days.

Broker Statement

DENIED. OUR RECORDS REFLECT THE CLIENT MET WITH THE FINANCIAL ADVISOR APRIL 7, 2011. DURING THAT MEETING, THEY AGREED THE PORTFOLIO WAS NOT POSITIONED TO MEET HER CHANGING OBJECTIVE OF INCOME. IT IS OUR UNDERSTANDING THE ADVISOR EXPLAINED THE CLIENT MAY BE SUBJECT TO TAX ON LONG TERM CAPITAL GAINS. THE ADVISOR IS NOT A TAX ADVISOR AND THEREFORE RECOMMENDED SHE SPEAK WITH A TAX PROFESSIONAL FOR DETAILS.

ON MARCH 28, 2012, THE CLIENT VISITED THE BRANCH TO REVIEW THE HIGH TAX LIABILITY. IN REVIEW WITH HOME OFFICE, IT WAS DETERMINED THE 'NON-COVERED' GAINS WHICH ARE NOT REPORTED TO THE INTERNAL REVENUE SERVICE (IRS) BUT MAY BE REQUIRED TO BE REPORTED BY THE CLIENT, WERE LISTED AS SHORT TERM RATHER THAN LONG TERM GAINS. IT IS OUR UNDERSTANDING THE TAX PROFESSIONAL RECOMMENDED FILING THE 2011 TAX RETURN WITH THE SHORT TERM GAINS, AND AMENDING THE RETURN UPON RECEIPT OF THE CORRECTED FORM 1099.

IT IS OUR POSITION THAT THE CLIENT WAS MADE AWARE OF POTENTIAL TAX LIABILITY RESULTING FROM THE REPOSITIONING OF INVESTMENTS IN 2011 AND HAD PREVIOUS EXPERIENCE WITH CAPITAL GAINS. OUR REVIEW REFLECTS SIMILAR ACTIVITY IN 2009, WHEN THE CLIENT LIQUIDATED \$35,000 OF MUTUAL FUNDS AND REPOSITIONED TO INCOME PRODUCING INVESTMENTS.

THOUGH THE 'NON-COVERED' CAPITAL GAINS INFORMATION PROVIDED ON THE FORM 1099 IS NOT SENT TO THE IRS, THE ORIGINAL FORM 1099 DID CONTAIN ERRONEOUS INFORMATION. THEREFORE, AS A SERVICE GESTURE, WE HAVE ISSUED A CHECK FOR \$100 TO REIMBURSE THE CLIENT THE AMENDMENT FEE ASSESSED BY THE TAX PROFESSIONAL
