IAPD Information About Representatives

IAPD offers information on all current-and many former representatives. Investors are strongly encouraged to use IAPD to check the background of representatives before deciding to conduct, or continue to conduct, business with them.

What is included in a IAPD report?

IAPD reports for individual representatives include information such as employment history, professional qualifications, disciplinary actions, criminal convictions, civil judgments and arbitration awards.

It is important to note that the information contained in an IAPD report may include pending actions or allegations that may be contested, unresolved or unproven. In the end, these actions or allegations may be resolved in favor of the representative, or concluded through a negotiated settlement with no admission or finding of wrongdoing.

Where did this information come from?

The information contained in IAPD comes from the Investment Adviser Registration Depository (IARD) and FINRA's Central Registration Depository, or CRD, (see more on CRD below) and is a combination of:

- information the states require representatives and firms to submit as part of the registration and licensing process, and
- information that state regulators report regarding disciplinary actions or allegations against representatives.

How current is this information?

Generally, representatives are required to update their professional and disciplinary information in IARD within 30 days.

Broker Statement	I was working as a sub-contractor. Typically the type of work being performed is done prior to the wood floor being installed. Due to poor management/scheduling by the general contractor on the construction site, the flooring was installed prior to the installation of the truss attached athletic equipment; therefore I was working over a finished floor with heavy equipment, including a scissor lift. I followed the contractors protocol to protect the flooring which entailed a large canvas and 4/8 plywood sheets. When the job was completed, the contractor claimed there was some cosmetic damage to the floor. There were other contractors working in the gymnasium the entire time I was there and I believe the damage was caused by other contractors. Rather than disputing the charges, the bonding company that represented me decided to pay the amount being requested by the school, in full. They made no attempt to negotiate a settlement or represent me to dispute the charges. I was later advised by the sub-contractor that I sub-contracted to that the school would have been willing to agree to a settlement of 6-7 thousand dollars, as the damage was only cosmetic in nature and they could not prove definitively who had caused the damage.
