IAPD offers information on all current-and many former representatives. Investors are strongly encouraged to use IAPD to check the background of representatives before deciding to conduct, or continue to conduct, business with them.

What is included in a IAPD report?

IAPD reports for individual representatives include information such as employment history, professional qualifications, disciplinary actions, criminal convictions, civil judgments and arbitration awards.

It is important to note that the information contained in an IAPD report may include pending actions or allegations that may be contested, unresolved or unproven. In the end, these actions or allegations may be resolved in favor of the representative, or concluded through a negotiated settlement with no admission or finding of wrongdoing.

Where did this information come from?

The information contained in IAPD comes from the Investment Adviser Registration Depository (IARD) and FINRA's Central Registration Depository, or CRD, (see more on CRD below) and is a combination of:

- information the states require representatives and firms to submit as part of the registration and licensing process, and
- information that state regulators report regarding disciplinary actions or allegations against representatives.

How current is this information?

Generally, representatives are required to update their professional and disciplinary information in IARD within 30 days.

THE CLIENT STATES THIS WAS NOT DONE IN DECEMBER 2007; HE STATES HE INFORMED THE FA HE DID NOT CARE IF HE DID NOT MAKE ANY MONEY HE JUST DID NOT WANT TO LOSE ANY MORE. THE CLIENT STATES THE FA RECOMMENDED AIG SUNAMERICA ANNUITY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$150,000 AND GE CAPITAL BOND FOR \$100,000. THE CLIENT STATES HE LOST MORE MONEY. THE CLIENT STATES HE WAS ALSO INVESTED IN FOUR DIFFERENT FUNDS OF THE SAME TYPE; HE INDICATES THERE SHOULD HAVE BEEN A BREAKPOINT.

OUR RECORDS INDICATE THERE WERE SEVERAL TRANSACTIONS IN THE JOINT ACCOUNT TO HELP REBALANCE YOUR ACCOUNT TOWARDS YOUR STATED OBJECTIVE OF GROWTH AND INCOME. THE FA INDICATES HE REVIEWED WITH THE CLIENT THE CALL PROVISION, AND HOW IT COULD AFFECT THE INCOME COULD CHANGE IF THE BOND WAS CALLED. IT IS OUR UNDERSTANDING AFTER REVIEWING THE INFORMATION PROVIDED ON THE BOND, THE CLIENT AGREED TO LIQUIDATE \$100,000 IN MUTUAL FUNDS TO PURCHASE THE BOND ON JANUARY 8, 2008. THE FA REVIEWED WITH THE CLIENT THE AIG SUNAMERICA POLARIS II VARIABLE ANNUITY WITH MARKETLOCK INCOME FEATURE. ACCORDING TO THE FA, HE EXPLAINED HOW THE MARKETLOCK WORKS, THE INVESTMENT OPTIONS WITHIN THE ANNUITY, DEATH BENEFIT, TAX CONSEQUENCES FOR THE HEIRS AND RISKS. THE FA STATES HE INFORMED THE CLIENT THE ANNUITY COULD FLUCTUATE, BUT THE INCOME STREAM WOULD BE PROTECTED REGARDLESS OF THE FLUCTUATION. UPON OUR REVIEW, TWO OF THE FOUR FUND FAMILIES WERE TRANSFERRED FROM A PREVIOUS FIRM. IN ADDITION, THE CLIENT RECEIVED BREAKPOINTS ON VAN KAMPEN FUNDS BEGINNING IN 2005 AND PUTNAM FUNDS IN 2007.
