IAPD Information About Representatives

IAPD offers information on all current-and many former representatives. Investors are strongly encouraged to use IAPD to check the background of representatives before deciding to conduct, or continue to conduct, business with them.

What is included in a IAPD report?

IAPD reports for individual representatives include information such as employment history, professional qualifications, disciplinary actions, criminal convictions, civil judgments and arbitration awards.

- information that state regulators report regarding disciplinary actions or allegations against representatives.

Broker Statement I assisted the client in getting an in-service withdrawal from their company sponsored plan. I discussed the potential of taking advantage of the Net Unrealized Appreciation concept. I further explained to the client that I do not provide tax advice and that she should consult with a tax advisor. Two years after the transaction, the client was sent a revised 1099 which subsequently resulted in a taxable event in excess of \$100,000. This event generated an allegation from the client that I erred when I told her she was entitled to Net Unrealized Appreciation Tax treatment.
