### Customer Dispute

This section provides information regarding a customer dispute that was reported to the Investment Adviser Registration Depository (IARD) by the Investment Adviser Representative (IAR), an investment adviser and/or securities firm, and/or a securities regulator. **Employing firm when activities occurred which led to the complaint:** Hutchens & Kramer Investment Management Group, LLC d/b/a Monon Wealth Management.

**Allegations:** On August 16, 2018, Claimants became clients of Monon Wealth Management, and terminated their relationship on June 28, 2023. On December 16, 2025, Claimants, through their counsel, submitted to Respondents a Demand for Restitution related to an investment recommended by Respondents (GWG Holdings L Bond) and breach of fiduciary duty during their relationship with Monon Wealth Management. A settlement was reached, and an agreement was signed by the Respondents on February 13, 2026 and by the Claimants on February 10, 2026.

**Broker Statement**

In December 2025, former clients, through counsel, submitted a demand for restitution related to the purchase of GWG Holdings L-Bonds in November 2020 while their accounts were managed on a discretionary basis. At the time of purchase, the GWG L-Bond investment represented approximately 3% of the clients' overall portfolio. The investment was made within an advisory account, and I did not receive any commission or additional compensation related to the transaction.

The clients were invested in a Growth and Income portfolio aligned with their documented risk tolerance. The investment was intended as a limited, income-oriented allocation within the fixed income portion of their portfolio. At the time, GWG Holdings was a publicly traded company subject to SEC reporting requirements, and its financial statements were audited by a nationally recognized accounting firm. Due diligence was conducted based on publicly available information and direct communications with the issuer.

Subsequently, GWG Holdings was revealed to have engaged in fraudulent activity, resulting in default and investor losses. This outcome was not foreseeable based on the information available at the time of the investment. The clients later alleged breach of fiduciary duty and unsuitable investment recommendations. These allegations are denied.

To avoid the time, expense, and uncertainty of litigation, the matter was resolved through a negotiated settlement in February 2026 for \$50,000. The settlement was a business decision and does not constitute an admission of liability or wrongdoing.

I remain committed to acting in the best interests of my clients and to continually refining due diligence and portfolio construction processes.
