What is included in a IAPD report?

IAPD reports for individual representatives include information such as employment history, professional qualifications, disciplinary actions, criminal convictions, civil judgments and arbitration awards.

It is important to note that the information contained in an IAPD report may include pending actions or allegations that may be contested, unresolved or unproven. In the end, these actions or allegations may be resolved in favor of the representative, or concluded through a negotiated settlement with no admission or finding of wrongdoing.

Where did this information come from?

The information contained in IAPD comes from the Investment Adviser Registration Depository (IARD) and FINRA's Central Registration Depository, or CRD, (see more on CRD below) and is a combination of:

- information the states require representatives and firms to submit as part of the registration and licensing process, and
- information that state regulators report regarding disciplinary actions or allegations against representatives.

Allegations: CLIENT INDICATES HE TRANSFERRED \$225,000 TO EDJ AND HE UNDERSTOOD HIS FUNDS WITH T ROWE PRICE, AMERICAN EXPRESS AND JANUS WOULD NEED TO BE LIQUIDATED AS EDJ COULD NOT HOLD THEM. CLIENT STATES HE BELIEVED THE FIDELITY FUNDS WERE TRANSFERRED IN KIND, HOWEVER, WHEN CLIENT RECEIVED HIS TAX STATEMENT FROM EDJ IT INDICATED THE FIDELITY FUNDS HAD BEEN LIQUIDATED. CLIENT STATES THE LIQUIDATION OF THE FIDELITY FUNDS COST HIM AN ADDITIONAL \$8,000 IN FEDERAL INCOME TAX AND \$1,900 IN STATE TAX.

Broker Statement ACCORDING TO FA, HE BEGAN MEETING WITH THE CLIENT IN NOVEMBER



2005 AND AT THAT TIME CLIENT EXPRESSED INTEREST IN MOVING THEIR ASSETS TO EDWARD JONES AND ORGANIZING THEIR PORTFOLIO. WHILE IT IS MY UNDERSTANDING CLIENT ESTABLISHED HIS IRA WITH OUR FIRM IN NOVEMBER AND BEGAN TRANSFERRING ASSETS TO THIS ACCOUNT; IT WAS NOT UNTIL THE MEETING (WITH CLIENT, HIS WIFE AND FA) ON DECEMBER 30, 2005 THAT THE JOINT ACCOUNT WAS ESTABLISHED AND PAPERWORK WAS COMPLETED TO TRANSFER IN KIND ASSETS FROM FIDELITY, DREYFUS AND T. ROWE PRICE. FA INDICATED THE ONLY ACCOUNT THAT COULD NOT BE TRANSFERRED IN KIND WAS FROM AMERICAN EXPRESS AND CLIENT CHOSE NOT TO LIQUIDATE THAT ACCOUNT. IT IS OUR UNDERSTANDING THE CLIENT AND HIS WIFE MET WITH THE FA ON JANUARY 16, 2006 AND REVIEWED THE FA'S RECOMMENDATIONS TO REBALANCE THE PORTFOLIO IN THEIR JOINT ACCOUNT. FA STATED DURING THIS MEETING HE DISCUSSED THE FIDELITY EXCHANGES AND INFORMED THE CLIENTS THAT ALTHOUGH THIS WOULD NOT GENERATE A COMMISSION, THERE COULD BE TAXES ASSOCIATED WITH THIS ACTIVITY. FA INDICATED HE HAD SPOKEN WITH THE CLIENT AND HIS WIFE SEVERAL TIMES DURING THE REBALANCING OF THEIR PORTFOLIOS AND ALL TRANSACTIONS WERE AUTHORIZED. ALL TRANSACTIONS WERE REFLECTED ON CLIENTS' JANUARY 2006 CUSTOMER ACCOUNT STATEMENT AND THE FIDELITY EXCHANGE ACTIVITY WAS REPORTED UNDER PROCEEDS FROM SECURITIES SOLD. IT DOES NOT APPEAR CLIENT EXPRESSED CONCERN REGARDING THIS ACCOUNT ACTIVITY UNTIL THE CORRESPONDENCE DATED APRIL 13, 2007. BASED ON OUR REVIEW OF THIS MATTER, IT DOES APPEAR THROUGH CONVERSATIONS WITH THE FA AND CUSTOMER ACCOUNT STATEMENTS CLIENT WAS AWARE OF THE POTENTIAL TAX CONSEQUENCES ASSOCIATED WITH THE MUTUAL FUND ACTIVITY IN THE ACCOUNT. AS SUCH, WE RESPECTFULLY DENY CLIENT'S REQUEST TO REIMBURSE THE TAXES ASSOCIATED WITH THE MUTUAL FUND ACTIVITY IN JANUARY 2006.
