IAPD Information About Representatives

IAPD offers information on all current-and many former representatives. Investors are strongly encouraged to use IAPD to check the background of representatives before deciding to conduct, or continue to conduct, business with them.

What is included in a IAPD report?

IAPD reports for individual representatives include information such as employment history, professional qualifications, disciplinary actions, criminal convictions, civil judgments and arbitration awards.

It is important to note that the information contained in an IAPD report may include pending actions or allegations that may be contested, unresolved or unproven. In the end, these actions or allegations may be resolved in favor of the representative, or concluded through a negotiated settlement with no admission or finding of wrongdoing.

Where did this information come from?

The information contained in IAPD comes from the Investment Adviser Registration Depository (IARD) and FINRA's Central Registration Depository, or CRD, (see more on CRD below) and is a combination of:

- information the states require representatives and firms to submit as part of the registration and licensing process, and
- information that state regulators report regarding disciplinary actions or allegations against representatives.

How current is this information?

Generally, representatives are required to update their professional and disciplinary information in IARD within 30 days.

CLIENT CLAIMS THE FA INFORMED HIM HE WOULD PLACE THE PRICE AT \$243 NOT THE \$240 PLACED ON THE ORDER. CLIENT CLAIMS THE FEES WERE OUTRAGEOUS AND HE WAS NOT INFORMED OF THE FEES PRIOR TO THE ORDERS BEING PLACED. THROUGH OUR INVESTIGATION, IT IS MY UNDERSTANDING CLIENT INITIATED THE CONVERSATION WITH FA ON AAPL IN WHICH ISSUES SURROUNDING AAPL WERE DISCUSSED. IT WAS SUGGESTED BY FA THAT AN OPEN STOP ORDER BE PLACED AS A PRECAUTION AS HE WOULD BE OUT OF TOWN AND UNABLE TO WATCH THE PRICE. RECORDS REFLECT AN OPEN STOP ORDER WAS PLACED ON JULY 2, 2010 AT THE PRICE OF \$240 AND FOR THE NUMBER OF SHARES DISCUSSED. FURTHER, OUR INVESTIGATION INDICATES CLIENT WAS AWARE OF OUR GENERAL COMMISSION CHARGES ASSOCIATED WITH TRADES AND WHILE NOT REQUIRED TO DO SO, FA PROVIDED CLIENT WITH A 50% DISCOUNT ON THE COMMISSION ASSOCIATED WITH THE TRADES. OPEN ORDER TRADE CONFIRMATIONS WERE MAILED TO ADDRESS OF RECORD REFLECTING PRICE AND SHARES ON JULY 2, 2010. THE OPEN ORDERS EXECUTED ON JULY 19, 2010 AND TRADE CONFIRMATIONS SETTING OUT THE EXECUTION OF THE OPEN ORDERS WERE MAILED. THE TRADE CONFIRMATIONS, TO INCLUDE THE OPEN TRADE CONFIRMATIONS, DO INDICATE THE TRADE INFORMATION IS ASSUMED CORRECT UNLESS WE ARE IMMEDIATELY NOTIFIED. WHILE THE OPEN ORDER WAS PLACED ON JULY 2, 2010, THE ORDER DID NOT EXECUTE UNTIL JULY 19, 2010. OUR INVESTIGATION WOULD INDICATE CLIENT MADE NO ATTEMPT TO NOTIFY US THAT THE OPEN ORDER WAS INCORRECT AND, THEREFORE, THE ORDER WAS DEEMED ACCURATE AND EXECUTED ACCORDINGLY. CLAIM DENIED.
