What is included in a IAPD report?

IAPD reports for individual representatives include information such as employment history, professional qualifications, disciplinary actions, criminal convictions, civil judgments and arbitration awards.

It is important to note that the information contained in an IAPD report may include pending actions or allegations that may be contested, unresolved or unproven. In the end, these actions or allegations may be resolved in favor of the representative, or concluded through a negotiated settlement with no admission or finding of wrongdoing.

Where did this information come from?

The information contained in IAPD comes from the Investment Adviser Registration Depository (IARD) and FINRA's Central Registration Depository, or CRD, (see more on CRD below) and is a combination of:

- information the states require representatives and firms to submit as part of the registration and licensing process, and
- information that state regulators report regarding disciplinary actions or allegations against representatives.

The client had an ongoing relationship with rep and rep worked over 10 months to roll over client lump sum pension. This was not a quick nor easy process. client had multiple opportunities to back out of the roll-over. The investments made a positive return and the investments were aligned with



client stated investment objective. When the client indicated that he was confused, rep met with him and advised him to withdraw his application and utilize his free look period. The client received all of his funds in return plus gains for the ten days that he held the contract. The only time that rep met the client was when he called to set an appointment. Rep never pressured him in a branch nor via the telephone. This transaction was fully documented. The prior firm decided to settle due to the high cost of defense. Rep had no part in the claimant's hearing and was not allowed in the meeting to refute any claims.
