IAPD offers information on all current-and many former representatives. Investors are strongly encouraged to use IAPD to check the background of representatives before deciding to conduct, or continue to conduct, business with them.

What is included in a IAPD report?

IAPD reports for individual representatives include information such as employment history, professional qualifications, disciplinary actions, criminal convictions, civil judgments and arbitration awards.

It is important to note that the information contained in an IAPD report may include pending actions or allegations that may be contested, unresolved or unproven. In the end, these actions or allegations may be resolved in favor of the representative, or concluded through a negotiated settlement with no admission or finding of wrongdoing.

Where did this information come from?

The information contained in IAPD comes from the Investment Adviser Registration Depository (IARD) and FINRA's Central Registration Depository, or CRD, (see more on CRD below) and is a combination of:

- information the states require representatives and firms to submit as part of the registration and licensing process, and
- information that state regulators report regarding disciplinary actions or allegations against representatives.

How current is this information?

Generally, representatives are required to update their professional and disciplinary information in IARD within 30 days.

The attorney representing the trustees alleges that the FA allowed the client to withdraw funds against his line of credit and from the client's Wealth Management Account to fund wire transfers despite diminished cognitive function. The attorney further alleges that the client was deceived by an ongoing "Mega Millions" lottery scam which promised he client a \$60 million dollar cash prize and additional prizes. The alleged damages are estimated to be in excess of \$5,000.00.

I had no knowledge of the "Mega Millionaires" scheme. Had the client told me the true intended use of the funds, I would have done my best to dissuade him. Perhaps this is why he failed to reveal to me how he truly intended to use those funds. I have known this client for over thirteen (13) years and found no indication of diminished cognitive function, as is now claimed by the trustees. I believe that these allegations are false and are merely an attempt to recoup monies lost in the fraudulent scheme.
