IAPD Information About Representatives

IAPD offers information on all current-and many former representatives. Investors are strongly encouraged to use IAPD to check the background of representatives before deciding to conduct, or continue to conduct, business with them.

What is included in a IAPD report?

IAPD reports for individual representatives include information such as employment history, professional qualifications, disciplinary actions, criminal convictions, civil judgments and arbitration awards.

It is important to note that the information contained in an IAPD report may include pending actions or allegations that may be contested, unresolved or unproven. In the end, these actions or allegations may be resolved in favor of the representative, or concluded through a negotiated settlement with no admission or finding of wrongdoing.

Where did this information come from?

The information contained in IAPD comes from the Investment Adviser Registration Depository (IARD) and FINRA's Central Registration Depository, or CRD, (see more on CRD below) and is a combination of:

- information the states require representatives and firms to submit as part of the registration and licensing process, and
- information that state regulators report regarding disciplinary actions or allegations against representatives.

How current is this information?

Generally, representatives are required to update their professional and disciplinary information in IARD within 30 days.

Broker Statement	RECORDS REFLECT INITIAL LIQUIDATION OF WAYNE SAVINGS BANCSHARES INC. OCCURRED IN SEPT 2004 WITH [THIRD PARTY] AND ADDITIONAL SHARES WERE LIQUIDATED IN FEB 2005 WITH MR. JAY. BOTH IRS INDICATED YOU HAD A SUBSTANTIAL HOLDING IN THE STOCK. THEY
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BOTH STATED THEY DISCUSSED WITH YOU THE RISKS ASSOCIATED WITH HOLDING SUCH A SIZEABLE POSITION IN ONE STOCK AND SUGGESTED REDUCING THE POSITION. [THIRD PARTY] STATED HE RECOMMENDED BETTER DIVERSIFYING PORTFOLIO BY INVESTING IN AMERICAN FUNDS. HOWEVER, DUE TO POTENTIAL TAX LIABILITIES HE STATED HE RECOMMENDED NOT SELLING ALL OR THE MAJORITY OF THE STOCK. HE FURTHER STATED HE DISCUSSED WORKING WITH AN ACCOUNTANT TO LOOK AT TAX SITUATION. ACCORDING TO [THIRD PARTY] HE SPOKE WITH ACCOUNTANT TO NOTIFY HIM OF ACTIVITY. MR. JAY STATED IN FEB 2005 HE ALSO DISCUSSED LIQUIDATING ADDITIONAL SHARES FOR SAME REASONS. ADDITIONAL SHARES WERE LIQUIDATED IN FEB 2005. IT IS MY UNDERSTANDING, MR. JAY LATER LEARNED THE CLIENT DID NOT HAVE THE COST BASIS ON THIS STOCK (TRANSFERRED TO YOUR EDWARD JONES ACCOUNT IN OCT 2000) AND HE, THEREFORE, ASSISTED WITH OBTAINING THIS INFORMATION. WHILE CLIENT MAY NOT HAVE BEEN AWARE OF THE EXACT AMOUNT OF POTENTIAL TAX LIABILITY, SHE WAS AWARE THE LIQUIDATION OF THE SHARES COULD RESULT IN TAXES BEING OWED. CLAIM DENIED. MR. JAY STATED HE DID SPEAK WITH CLIENT REGARDING HOW ASSETS WITHIN TRUST WOULD BE HANDLED IN THE EVENT OF HER DEATH. ACCORDING TO MR. JAY, HE ADVISED CLIENT TO SPEAK WITH ATTORNEY WHO ESTABLISHED THE TRUST.
