Ms. [REDACTED] is incorrect in her belief about the decline in the value of her accounts while she was working with me. Ms. [REDACTED] did not invest or lose \$600,000 with me. She only put approximately \$440,000 under management with me. When Ms. [REDACTED] chose to close her accounts in April 2023, she withdrew approximately \$264,000. Ms. [REDACTED]'s accounts with me didn't decline by anything like the \$600,000 she claims.

Based on what Ms. [REDACTED] told me, I believed I was managing only about one-half of her liquid assets. She told me that she had approximately \$200,000 in cash and about \$200,000 in a 401K outside my management. She told me that her time horizon for her funds invested with me was ten years.

Ms. [REDACTED] agreed that the assets I had under management for her would be the growth portion of her overall portfolio and that assets she held outside my management would provide diversification and offset risk in the accounts I managed for her.

Ms. [REDACTED] told me that she had a ten-year period in which she was investing her funds with me for growth. I advised her that with her objective for growth in that portion of her portfolio, she might experience a decline in a year but that, with her ten-year horizon, she would be well placed to overcome and advance from such a loss. She understood and agreed to the strategy I undertook for her and to the corresponding risk.

From January 1, 2023, through April 2023, when Ms. [REDACTED] closed her accounts with me, her accounts under my management saw a significant return. Just as I told her, while short-term fluctuations in her accounts were to be expected, with her ten-year horizon, she would see the short-term declines recover. If she had left her accounts with me, she would have seen significant growth in her account so far in 2023.

I don't understand Ms. [REDACTED] complaint about me not communicating with her. I communicated with her often and regularly in response to her requests for information and questions.

Many investors suffered portfolio losses in 2022 with the widespread market decline. That decline touched Ms. [REDACTED]'s accounts with me. But I'm not at fault in causing the decline in her accounts in 2022. Her accounts with me were invested consistently with the growth objective and risk tolerance she directed to me.
