Where did this information come from?

Broker Statement

I deny the allegation and believe the allegations made to be unjustified. The customer was a qualified investor who claimed that he had not been given certain information prior to making a private placement investment. Upon review of the documents, it was evident that not only had the customer been provided with the information in question before making the investment, but that it was contained within the documents he signed at the time he ratified the investment. Furthermore, Credit Suisse, after reviewing the client's concerns, denied the client's complaint in March 2017.
