**Broker Statement**

Citi International Financial Services (CIFS) brought an arbitration against my current firm alleging, among other things, that I had taken and was using at my current firm, information CIFS claimed was confidential and proprietary to it. CIFS sought permanent injunctive relief seeking, among other things, an Order to prevent me from using or otherwise possessing such information. On May 26, 2015, the Arbitration Panel issued an Order DENYING CIFS's request for injunctive relief.
