IAPD Information About Representatives

IAPD offers information on all current-and many former representatives. Investors are strongly encouraged to use IAPD to check the background of representatives before deciding to conduct, or continue to conduct, business with them.

What is included in a IAPD report?

IAPD reports for individual representatives include information such as employment history, professional qualifications, disciplinary actions, criminal convictions, civil judgments and arbitration awards.

It is important to note that the information contained in an IAPD report may include pending actions or allegations that may be contested, unresolved or unproven. In the end, these actions or allegations may be resolved in favor of the representative, or concluded through a negotiated settlement with no admission or finding of wrongdoing.

Where did this information come from?

The information contained in IAPD comes from the Investment Adviser Registration Depository (IARD) and FINRA's Central Registration Depository, or CRD, (see more on CRD below) and is a combination of:

- information the states require representatives and firms to submit as part of the registration and licensing process, and
- information that state regulators report regarding disciplinary actions or allegations against representatives.

How current is this information?

Generally, representatives are required to update their professional and disciplinary information in IARD within 30 days.

CLIENT'S FIDELITY STATEMENT TO INITIATE THE TRANSFER TO OUR FIRM. THE IR CONTENDS THE CLIENT WAS INSISTENT ON LIQUIDATING THE FIDELITY IRA HIMSELF AND THAT HE WOULD BRING THE IR THE CHECK WHEN IT WAS RECEIVED. AS STATED IN THE CLIENT'S LETTER, OUR RECORDS REFLECT THAT NUMEROUS CHECKS WERE RECEIVED FROM THE LIQUIDATIONS. THE IR HAS STATED IT IS HIS BELIEF NUMEROUS CHECKS WERE RECEIVED BECAUSE THE CLIENT DID NOT PROVIDE FIDELITY WITH INSTRUCTIONS TO LIQUIDATE THE ENTIRE ACCOUNT AT ONE TIME, BUT PROVIDED SELL INSTRUCTIONS TO FIDELITY AT DIFFERENT TIMES. BASED ON OUR INVESTIGATION, IT APPEARS THE SELL/TRANSFER WAS FACILITATED BY THE CLIENT WITH NO ASSISTANCE FROM THE IR. ADDITIONALLY, THE IR HAS STATED THAT HE DID NOT DIRECT OR INSTRUCT THE CLIENT TO PERFORM THE MULTIPLE INDIRECT ROLLOVERS. BASED ON THIS, THE REQUEST FOR COMPENSATION WAS DENIED.
