## IAPD Information About Representatives

**Broker Statement**

Claimant became a client in 2020 needed financial guidance on what to do with proceeds from the settlement. We shared over a dozen meetings between 2020 and early 2022 related to her investments and she felt that this investment would provide income she desired that was otherwise unattainable in the general bond market at the time, due to close to 0% interest rates. After several discussions on the investment and clarifying that it was a small portion of her total net worth (under 5%), it was worth locking it up for several years. It was discussed that all investments come with risks and that the risk of loss was one of those. She filed a claim related to this investment in late 2022 and after many discussions through attorneys, Brittany agreed to buy the shares back from the client based on the value that could be ascertained at the time.
