During a routine exam of books and records by the State of Michigan in May of 2011, the State inquired about Private Placements offered by DEG that were offered to some clients. Woodcrest Investments, LLC and Nancy Bartolameolli had already stopped offering DEG Bonds to their clients once they learned the issuer was under review. Five years later, The State issued a Notice and Order to Cease and Desist against Woodcrest Investments, LLC and Ms. Bartolameolli and intended to issue a fine in the amount of \$10,000 to both Woodcrest Investments, LLC and Ms. Bartolameolli for the sale of unregistered securities, this came years after Ms. Bartolameolli had already taken action to no longer recommend this asset. There have been no client complaints related to this incident even after the State contacted the clients. Without denying or agreeing to the allegations of the sale of unregistered securities, Woodcrest and Ms. Bartolameolli cooperated in good faith to close the matter and have the issue resolved. On November 22, 2016, the firm and Nancy Bartolameolli signed a Consent Order with the State of Michigan. The final resolution required both the firm and Nancy Bartolameolli to pay a minor monetary fine of \$1,000 dollars as opposed to the original request of \$10,000 each. The fines were paid in full on December 15, 2016.
