IAPD Information About Representatives

IAPD offers information on all current-and many former representatives. Investors are strongly encouraged to use IAPD to check the background of representatives before deciding to conduct, or continue to conduct, business with them.

What is included in a IAPD report?

IAPD reports for individual representatives include information such as employment history, professional qualifications, disciplinary actions, criminal convictions, civil judgments and arbitration awards.

It is important to note that the information contained in an IAPD report may include pending actions or allegations that may be contested, unresolved or unproven. In the end, these actions or allegations may be resolved in favor of the representative, or concluded through a negotiated settlement with no admission or finding of wrongdoing.

Where did this information come from?

The information contained in IAPD comes from the Investment Adviser Registration Depository (IARD) and FINRA's Central Registration Depository, or CRD, (see more on CRD below) and is a combination of:

- information the states require representatives and firms to submit as part of the registration and licensing process, and
- information that state regulators report regarding disciplinary actions or allegations against representatives.

How current is this information?

Generally, representatives are required to update their professional and disciplinary information in IARD within 30 days.

Broker Statement ON JUNE 5TH, 2013 I REVIEWED CERTAIN PENDING OUTSTANDING COMPLIANCE ISSUES WITH A NEWLY HIRED REGISTERED



REPRESENTATIVE ("RR") UNDER MY SUPERVISION. IN THE PREVIOUS MONTH THE RR DISCUSSED A TRADE WITH A CLIENT BUT THE RR INADVERTENTLY AND INCORRECTLY FILLED OUT THE COST COMPARISON ACKNOWLEDGEMENT. THIS WAS AN INTERNAL J.P. MORGAN SECURITIES FORM WHICH INFORMS THE CUSTOMER OF THE BREAKPOINT (FOR LOAD MUTUAL FUNDS, THE DOLLAR AMOUNT FOR THE PURCHASE OF THE FUND'S SHARES THAT QUALIFIES THE INVESTOR FOR A REDUCED SALES CHARGE) TAKEN FROM FINRA'S BREAKPOINT CALCULATOR, AND DELINEATES THE TRADE AMOUNT AND THE APPLICABLE BREAKPOINTS. AFTER HIS OR HER REVIEW, THE CLIENT SIGNED THE SECOND PAGE OF THE FORM AND INDICATES THE SHARE CLASS HE/OR SHE WISHES TO PURCHASES.

ON THIS PARTICULAR OCCASION, THE RR INFORMED ME THAT EARLIER IN THE MONTH HE RECEIVED THE SIGNED FORM AND THE TRADE HAD BEEN CLEARED. SINCE THE RR WAS A NEW HIRE, I DOUBLE CHECKED TO ENSURE COMPLETION, AND I NOTICED THE FORM WAS FILLED OUT INCORRECTLY. THE CLIENT MADE A RELATIVELY SHORT TERM PURCHASE WITH EXCESS CASH IN HIS BROKERAGE ACCOUNT AND PURCHASED C SHARE, BECAUSE THE POSITION WOULD ONLY BE HELD 18-36 MONTHS. WHERE THE FORM SAYS BREAKPOINT AVAILABLE TO THE CLIENT THE BROKER WROTE 0%, WHICH WAS INCORRECT. THE CORRECT BREAKPOINT WAS 2.5%. I REREAD THE INTERNAL INQUIRY FROM OUR COMPLIANCE DEPARTMENT, WHICH DID NOT REQUESTS NEW CLIENT SIGNATURE, SO I CORRECTED THE BREAKPOINT INFORMATION AND FAXED THE FIRST PAGE BACK TO THE RR.
