IAPD Information About Representatives

IAPD offers information on all current-and many former representatives. Investors are strongly encouraged to use IAPD to check the background of representatives before deciding to conduct, or continue to conduct, business with them.

What is included in a IAPD report?

IAPD reports for individual representatives include information such as employment history, professional qualifications, disciplinary actions, criminal convictions, civil judgments and arbitration awards.

It is important to note that the information contained in an IAPD report may include pending actions or allegations that may be contested, unresolved or unproven. Where did this information come from?

The information contained in IAPD comes from the Investment Adviser Registration Depository (IARD) and FINRA's Central Registration Depository, or CRD, (see more on CRD below) and is a combination of:

- information the states require representatives and firms to submit as part of the registration and licensing process, and
- information that state regulators report regarding disciplinary actions or allegations against representatives.

Generally, representatives are required to update their professional and disciplinary information in IARD within 30 days.

I disagree with and deny the allegations from the client. Prior to making the investment, the strategy was discussed in detail with the client several times over a period of a year with the managers of the strategy. The client is a very experienced investor and was made fully aware of the strategy's potential for volatility before investing and the types of market environments that could lead to greater downside volatility. The client also confirmed in writing that he understood the strategy was aggressive, carried a high degree of risk, and that significant market movements could result in losses. I was not named personally in the arbitration filing.
