IAPD Information About Representatives

IAPD offers information on all current-and many former representatives. Investors are strongly encouraged to use IAPD to check the background of representatives before deciding to conduct, or continue to conduct, business with them.

What is included in a IAPD report?

IAPD reports for individual representatives include information such as employment history, professional qualifications, disciplinary actions, criminal convictions, civil judgments and arbitration awards.

It is important to note that the information contained in an IAPD report may include pending actions or allegations that may be contested, unresolved or unproven. In the end, these actions or allegations may be resolved in favor of the representative, or concluded through a negotiated settlement with no admission or finding of wrongdoing.

Where did this information come from?

The information contained in IAPD comes from the Investment Adviser Registration Depository (IARD) and FINRA's Central Registration Depository, or CRD, (see more on CRD below) and is a combination of:

- information the states require representatives and firms to submit as part of the registration and licensing process, and
- information that state regulators report regarding disciplinary actions or allegations against representatives.

Generally, representatives are required to update their professional and disciplinary information in IARD within 30 days.

Broker Statement

The settlement was the result of a divorce. I owned a house with my ex-wife. We had a second mortgage on the house that hit the 10 year mark. This meant we needed to refinance the amount owed or the payment would balloon. My ex decided that she no longer cared about the house and cut off all communication with me. This meant I had no opportunity to refinance the debt in anyway. Every offer to make the payment affordable required her signature. She changed all her contact information and moved. She refused to do anything about the loan. Although I was doing everything possible to find a way to keep the house I could not afford the payment that resulted from the second mortgage. I was in contact with the lenders over a 5 month period trying to find a solution to making the second mortgage something I could afford to pay. Finally SunTrust offered to settle



the second mortgage if I could pay them \$30000.00 of the \$82632 I owed them. I was able to arrange payments with loans and family that allowed me to settle the debt and keep the house. I am currently in a situation that allows me to make the current payments on the residence until I can get cooperation on a sale.
