IAPD offers information on all current-and many former representatives. Investors are strongly encouraged to use IAPD to check the background of representatives before deciding to conduct, or continue to conduct, business with them.

What is included in a IAPD report?

IAPD reports for individual representatives include information such as employment history, professional qualifications, disciplinary actions, criminal convictions, civil judgments and arbitration awards.

It is important to note that the information contained in an IAPD report may include pending actions or allegations that may be contested, unresolved or unproven. In the end, these actions or allegations may be resolved in favor of the representative, or concluded through a negotiated settlement with no admission or finding of wrongdoing.

Where did this information come from?

The information contained in IAPD comes from the Investment Adviser Registration Depository (IARD) and FINRA's Central Registration Depository, or CRD, (see more on CRD below) and is a combination of:

- information the states require representatives and firms to submit as part of the registration and licensing process, and
- information that state regulators report regarding disciplinary actions or allegations against representatives.

How current is this information?

Generally, representatives are required to update their professional and disciplinary information in IARD within 30 days.

Customer Dispute

This section provides information regarding a customer dispute that was reported to the Investment Adviser Registration Depository (IARD) by the Investment Adviser Representative (IAR), an investment adviser and/or securities firm, and/or a securities regulator. The event may include a consumer-initiated, investment-related complaint, arbitration proceeding or civil suit that contains allegations of sales practice violations against the individual.

Reporting Source: Individual

Employing firm when activities occurred which led to the complaint: HANTZ FINANCIAL SERVICES, INC.

Allegations: [REDACTED] emailed his Registered Representative, Ryan Racine, on June 3, 2025, expressing concerns regarding his recently placed Prudential FlexGuard Annuity and Nationwide Variable Universal Life Insurance contract. He indicated that he felt these recommendations did not align with his and his wife's financial goals and liquidity needs. In response to [REDACTED] email, Hantz's Compliance Department conducted an investigation into his complaints and the recent recommendations made by Ryan Racine. During the investigation, Ryan Racine provided a timeline highlighting [REDACTED] longstanding relationship with Hantz and the positive service he has delivered to them.

Hantz's Compliance Department believes that the recommendations made to [REDACTED] were consistent with their financial goals and that both clients fully understood the features, benefits, and costs associated with their new contracts. Between the start of their relationship with Hantz in May 2023 and the date of their initial complaint, Ryan Racine held nearly a dozen meetings with [REDACTED]. In addition to providing sound investment recommendations, Ryan Racine and Hantz have assisted [REDACTED] with various financial matters, including property and casualty insurance, life insurance, debt consolidation, and tax planning. This comprehensive approach was designed to ensure that [REDACTED] benefited from the holistic planning model and the services for which they engaged us.

We find [REDACTED] complaints to be without merit, and Hantz's Director of Compliance formally responded to [REDACTED] on Friday, June 20,



2025, outlining the firm's investigative findings. Neither Ryan Racine nor Hantz's Compliance Department received any further communication from [REDACTED] following this formal response. On Saturday, November 15, 2025, [REDACTED] emailed Ryan Racine to officially terminate financial advisory services. Shortly thereafter, on November 17, 2025, Hantz Financial Services, Inc. and Ryan Racine were notified that they had been named as parties in Arbitration Number 25-02343 ([REDACTED] vs. Hantz Financial Services, Inc. and Ryan Racine).
