What is included in a IAPD report?

IAPD reports for individual representatives include information such as employment history, professional qualifications, disciplinary actions, criminal convictions, civil judgments and arbitration awards.

It is important to note that the information contained in an IAPD report may include pending actions or allegations that may be contested, unresolved or unproven. In the end, these actions or allegations may be resolved in favor of the representative, or concluded through a negotiated settlement with no admission or finding of wrongdoing.

Where did this information come from?

The information contained in IAPD comes from the Investment Adviser Registration Depository (IARD) and FINRA's Central Registration Depository, or CRD, (see more on CRD below) and is a combination of:

- information the states require representatives and firms to submit as part of the registration and licensing process, and
- information that state regulators report regarding disciplinary actions or allegations against representatives.

**Broker Statement**

I deny the allegations alleged against me and despite this matter was settled at mediation, there should be no inference of any liability or wrongdoing on my part whatsoever. This client hired me to manage a municipal bond portfolio. They received monthly statements and were aware of the investments made. There were no suitability issues or alleged "negligence" on my part whatsoever and to alleged misrepresentation based on one sheet of paper taken from hundreds of papers provided to the client which inadvertently left off the word "spread", that is just a false allegation. Despite my advice to not fully leverage the securities backed line of credit, the client did not listen or heed my recommendation. However, the client continued to spend large amounts of money and now having to deal with the IRS. This matter was settled to avoid the cost and uncertainty of the arbitration forum. I was not ask to contribute any monies toward the settlement of this matter.
