IAPD Information About Representatives

Broker Statement

On March 11, 2015 Oliver Blanco met with [REDACTED] to discuss potential investments with Monex Securities, Inc. ("Monex Securities"). [REDACTED] indicated that she wanted to invest (low risk) investments. From March 18, 2015 to April 23, 2015 [REDACTED] deposited \$403,370 with monex Securities. Monex Securities has established a Standard Deviation Range for assessing risk. The SD was established by analyzing the most common portfolios of mutual funds, the underlying assets held by the fund and the time the Investment is held. If the SD is 3.5 or less the risk is considered low. If the SD is greater than 3.5 or less than 6.5 the risk is moderate and if the SD is greater than 6.5 the risk is considered high. After conversations with [REDACTED] Mr. Blanco purchased 7 off-shore mutual funds between 4/1-4/23 on a solicited basis all of which fit into Monex Securities' SD below 3.5 defining low risk investment. The SD for the investments would be as follows; 3 year 2.30; 5 years 2.38 and 10 years 3.06. The Buy transactions were as follows: 3,146.632 MFS Meridian Limited Maturity Fund Class C1; 3,290/267 Caiamos Global Convertible Oportunites Fund class A US; 2,834.467 Alliance Berstein Short Duration High Yield Portfolio Class A2; 3371,544 MFS Meridian Research Bond Fund Class C1; and 668,747 Legg Mason Western Assets Macro Opportunities Fund Class A. Subsequent to the investments Mr. Blanco appraised [REDACTED] with the value of her account. Mr. Blanco again discussed he value of the account wih her on July 27th when the account was valued at \$394,954. On July 28th [REDACTED] requested that her account be closed and the proceeds transferred to another broker-dealer. Prior to her final decision, Mr. Blanco explained the realized loss she would incur as well as the CDSC and withdrawal costs. Never the less, [REDACTED] insisted on liquidating her positions and transferrin the funds. On September 12th, Jesus Heiras received an email from [REDACTED] with a letter attached dated September 5 alleging the unsuitable investments. On September 18th, Mr. Heiras responded to [REDACTED] stating that the matter was under investigation. Based on the investigation the firm believes that the investments were suitable but it has agreed to settle the matter for \$5,000 to avoid the expense and disruption of litigation. [REDACTED] has verbally agreed to the settlement.
