What is included in a IAPD report?

IAPD reports for individual representatives include information such as employment history, professional qualifications, disciplinary actions, criminal convictions, civil judgments and arbitration awards.

It is important to note that the information contained in an IAPD report may include pending actions or allegations that may be contested, unresolved or unproven. In the end, these actions or allegations may be resolved in favor of the representative, or concluded through a negotiated settlement with no admission or finding of wrongdoing.

Where did this information come from?

The information contained in IAPD comes from the Investment Adviser Registration Depository (IARD) and FINRA's Central Registration Depository, or CRD, (see more on CRD below) and is a combination of:

- information the states require representatives and firms to submit as part of the registration and licensing process, and
- information that state regulators report regarding disciplinary actions or allegations against representatives.

Allegations: THE CLIENTS INDICATE THAT IN FEBRUARY 2011 THEIR FINANCIAL ADVISOR SOLD PEPSICO AND YUM POSITIONS WITHOUT KNOWING THE ORIGINAL COST OF THE POSITIONS. THE TRADES COULD RESULT IN A \$25,000 TAX LIABILITY WHICH IS ALMOST THEIR ANNUAL INCOME. THE CLIENT ALLEGES THEY HAD NO KNOWLEDGE OF THE SALE UNTIL RECEIVING THE TRADE STATEMENT. THE CLIENTS FEEL THE ADVISOR SHOULD NOT HAVE SOLD THE STOCKS WITHOUT KNOWING THE ORIGINAL COST. THEY FEEL THE ADVISOR IS RESPONSIBLE FOR THEIR INCOME TAXES AND ACQUIRING COST BASIS INFORMATION FOR THEIR PURCHASES FROM THE CORPORATIONS.

Broker Statement

DENIED. OUR RECORDS REFLECT EQUITY POSITIONS YUM AND PEP WERE RECEIVED IN THE CLIENTS ' ACCOUNT ON FEBRUARY 18, 2011. MEETINGS ARE DOCUMENTED ON MARCH 18, 2011 AND MARCH 21, 2011 WITH THE LIQUIDATION OF YUM AND PEP ON MARCH 22, 2011. IT IS OUR UNDERSTANDING THAT THE FINANCIAL ADVISOR EXPLAINED THAT LIQUIDATING EQUITY POSITIONS WOULD CREATE TAX IMPLICATIONS, AND EXPLAINED HE IS NOT A TAX PROFESSIONAL, AND THEREFORE COULD NOT PROVIDE DETAILS. WHILE TAX IMPLICATIONS SHOULD BE CONSIDERED BY THE CLIENT WHEN MAKING INVESTMENT DECISIONS, THE FIRM WAS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR OBTAINING OR MAINTAINING COST BASIS INFORMATION FOR THE YUM AND PEP POSITIONS. ON APRIL 4, 2011 A MEETING IS DOCUMENTED WHERE THE CLIENT PRESENTED CONCERNS THAT THE STOCKS WOULD HAVE PAID THE MORTGAGE SHOULD ANYTHING HAPPEN TO HER HUSBAND. SHE FELT THAT AFTER TAXES AND COMMISSIONS WERE ASSESSED SHE HAD ALREADY LOST \$20,000, AND WAS CONCERNED IF SHE MADE THE RIGHT DECISION. THE NOTES INDICATE THAT WHILE THE CLIENT WAS NOT COMFORTABLE, HER HUSBAND, THE JOINT OWNER, BELIEVED IT WAS THE RIGHT DECISION AND THAT THEY WOULD MAINTAIN THE REPOSITIONED PORTFOLIO. THERE ARE MANY MEETINGS AND DISCUSSIONS DOCUMENTED THROUGHOUT THE REMAINDER OF 2011. IN AUGUST A SUGGESTION FOR OFFSETTING THE EQUITY GAINS WITH TRADE LOSSES WAS PRESENTED TO THE CLIENTS, AND OUR RECORDS REFLECT, REVIEWED BY THE CLIENTS WITH THEIR TAX PREPARER WHO DISCOURAGED THE CLIENTS FROM TAKING THE RECOMMENDATION. IT IS OUR OPINION THAT THE CLIENT WAS MADE AWARE OF CAPITAL GAINS TAXES APPLICABLE TO THE AUTHORIZED LIQUIDATIONS OF YUM AND PEP PRIOR TO EXECUTION OF THE TRADES.
