What is included in a IAPD report?

IAPD reports for individual representatives include information such as employment history, professional qualifications, disciplinary actions, criminal convictions, civil judgments and arbitration awards.

It is important to note that the information contained in an IAPD report may include pending actions or allegations that may be contested, unresolved or unproven. In the end, these actions or allegations may be resolved in favor of the representative, or concluded through a negotiated settlement with no admission or finding of wrongdoing.

Where did this information come from?

The information contained in IAPD comes from the Investment Adviser Registration Depository (IARD) and FINRA's Central Registration Depository, or CRD, (see more on CRD below) and is a combination of:

- information the states require representatives and firms to submit as part of the registration and licensing process, and
- information that state regulators report regarding disciplinary actions or allegations against representatives.

Allegations: On August 23, 2022, the firm received a written complaint from [REDACTED] (the "Clients") alleging that their client advisor, Kirk Israel ("Israel") acted negligently by (a) providing improper advice as to the tax consequences of IRA withdrawals, failing to inform them that in-kind securities transfers that Clients effected during calendar year 2021 from their qualified IRA accounts to their son's investment account at another financial institution were subject to federal and state income tax and (b) failing to withhold taxes from such IRA distributions, as they believed was the standard procedure.

Broker Statement	Following the complaint, Israel has produced contemporaneous notes evidencing that, in connection with the in-kind distribution requests, he (a) informed the Clients that any withdrawal from an IRA is subject to income taxes (but that there was no penalty for withdrawing the securities in-kind as opposed to making a cash withdrawal) and (b) asked Clients if they wanted to withhold taxes in connection with the in-kind distributions (informing them that some securities would have to be liquidated to cover the tax withholdings), but Clients declined to liquidate any securities or withhold taxes. Furthermore, the custodian's IRA/ESA Distribution Request forms, which were signed by the Clients with respect to the in-kind securities transfers, had the "Do NOT withhold" boxes checked with respect to both Federal and State income tax withholdings. The firm has engaged in settlement discussions with the client.
