IAPD Information About Representatives

IAPD offers information on all current-and many former representatives. Investors are strongly encouraged to use IAPD to check the background of representatives before deciding to conduct, or continue to conduct, business with them.

What is included in a IAPD report?

The representative denies any improper conduct and review by the Company confirmed that the customer authorized the electronic fund transfers from his bank account to the Company's home office to pay policy premiums on his non-variable life insurance policies. The Company found no merit to the customer's allegations.
