IAPD Information About Representatives

IAPD offers information on all current-and many former representatives. Investors are strongly encouraged to use IAPD to check the background of representatives before deciding to conduct, or continue to conduct, business with them.

What is included in a IAPD report?

IAPD reports for individual representatives include information such as employment history, professional qualifications, disciplinary actions, criminal convictions, civil judgments and arbitration awards.

It is important to note that the information contained in an IAPD report may include pending actions or allegations that may be contested, unresolved or unproven. In the end, these actions or allegations may be resolved in favor of the representative, or concluded through a negotiated settlement with no admission or finding of wrongdoing.

Where did this information come from?

The information contained in IAPD comes from the Investment Adviser Registration Depository (IARD) and FINRA's Central Registration Depository, or CRD, (see more on CRD below) and is a combination of:

- information the states require representatives and firms to submit as part of the registration and licensing process, and
- information that state regulators report regarding disciplinary actions or allegations against representatives.

How current is this information?

Generally, representatives are required to update their professional and disciplinary information in IARD within 30 days.

 - A "resolved" matter usually includes a disposition wherein no payment is made to the customer or there is no finding of wrongdoing on the part of the Investment Adviser Representative. Such matters generally involve customer disputes.

Broker Statement

I was acting in the capacity of a Notary Public, and was asked to notarize a non-securities related document (a certification of trust for a checking account) for a customer that a co worker was assisting. In accordance with firm policy, I locked my cell phone in my desk, picked up my notary journal and met the client in a conference room. I had just arrived in the office so I was unable to log in my



computer, check my voice mail, or email so I was not sure of the days date. I asked the client for the date while filing out my journal and they gave me the prior days date, which as a result I put in my notary journal and my on the attached Acknowledgement form that I then notarized. This created a discrepancy between the date that the signature card and the notary form had listed as the date signed and the actual date that the signatures were signed and uploaded to our database. This was discovered under review and determined to be "backdating". I was not financially compensated in any way for my notary service, nor was I to gain any compensation from client in question.
