## IAPD Information About Representatives

**Broker Statement**

ON THE EVENING OF MARCH 8, 1997 I WAS WITH A GROUP OF TEAMMATES FROM MY HIGH SCHOOL WRESTLING TEAM IN RAYMORE, MISSOURI. AT SOME POINT WE DECIDED TO DESTROY A GROUP OF MAILBOXES NEAR ONE OF THEIR HOMES. WE PLACED ALUMINUM FOIL IN PLASTIC TWO-LITER BOTTLES AND MIXED IT WITH TOILET BOWL CLEANER. THIS COMBINATION PRODUCED A CHEMICAL REACTION THAT CAUSED THE PLASTIC BOTTLES TO EXPAND AND BURST, SIMILAR TO A BALLOON BEING OVERINFLATED. BY PLACING THE BOTTLES IN THE CONFINES OF THE MAILBOXES, WHEN THEY EXPANDED AND BURST, IT POPPED THE RIVETS THAT HELD THE MAILBOXES TOGETHER, THEREBY DESTROYING THEM. I WAS ARRESTED AROUND FIVE DAYS LATER ALONG WITH THE SIX OTHER STUDENTS THAT WERE PRESENT THAT NIGHT. BY LEGAL DEFINITION, THE EXPANSION AND COMBUSTION OF THE BOTTLES IS CONSIDERED AN EXPLOSIVE, EVEN THOUGH IT DID NOT CREATE A FIRE. THE CHARGE WAS THEREFORE KNOWINGLY BURNING OR EXPLODING. IT WAS A STUPID MISTAKE I MADE AS A YOUNG DUMB KID. I WAS AN HONOR ROLL STUDENT-ATHLETE, BUT I HAD A MOMENTARY LAPSE OF JUDGMENT. I LEARNED A LOT FROM THIS INCIDENT, AND IT WAS GOOD FOR ME IN THE LONG-TERM.
