IAPD Information About Representatives

IAPD offers information on all current-and many former representatives. Investors are strongly encouraged to use IAPD to check the background of representatives before deciding to conduct, or continue to conduct, business with them.

What is included in a IAPD report?

IAPD reports for individual representatives include information such as employment history, professional qualifications, disciplinary actions, criminal convictions, civil judgments and arbitration awards.

Firm Statement Complaint settled for cost and reputational reasons as well as being unable to evidence the customer's acceptance and authorization of the dollar cost averaging investment plan. The firm could not determine with certainty that the missing documentation was due to rep error or if it was misplaced, misfiled or lost. Unfortunately, the authorization was not found or available, therefore, the firm chose to make the customer whole. The cost for doing so was \$82,866.74.

Broker Statement Representative Comment: Client came in to review options on matured fixed annuity in Q1 of 2021. The client was not pleased with the 5-year renewal rates offered. In Q1 of 2021 fixed 5-year annuity rates were between 2-3% while liquid savings account rates were under 1%. The client elected to use an annuity with market growth vs fixed rate to generate more appreciation. I recommended DCA into the subaccounts and explained the contract in full detail. All disclosures were provided to the client. The application for the exchange was signed by the client and approved by the broker dealer.

An annual review was held at the end of 2021. The client acknowledged the volatility and performance during 2021 and did not wish to make any changes to



the sub account investments. The client received monthly statements since inception providing him fluctuating account balances.

A liquid 4% guaranteed account was not available in Q1 2021 like it is today.
