## IAPD Information About Representatives

IAPD offers information on all current-and many former representatives. Investors are strongly encouraged to use IAPD to check the background of representatives before deciding to conduct, or continue to conduct, business with them.

### What is included in a IAPD report?

**Broker Statement**

Mr. Jones was advised by legal counsel to file for bankruptcy after he was misled by an individual whom he thought was a trusted colleague. Mr. Jones invested in a digital marketing startup in late 2019. In early 2020, he discovered that his colleague had provided false financial statements and materially misrepresented other facts concerning the terms of the deal. In addition to this, the COVID pandemic further complicated matters in terms of getting the venture off the ground, and the company failed soon after the start of the pandemic. Although Mr. Jones was opposed to the idea of filing bankruptcy, his attorney explained that it was a key course of action that would assist in recovering his severe loss of capital.
