**Regulator Statement**

On March 29, 2024, the Office of Financial Regulation (Office) entered a Final Order adopting the Stipulation and Consent Agreement in the matter of Maria Del Mar Castillo Dominguez (Castillo Dominguez). Castillo Dominguez neither admitted nor denied the allegations but consented to the entry of findings by the Office. The Office found that Castillo Dominguez violated section 517.12(4), Florida Statutes, by rendering investment advice, from a location within Florida, without being registered by the Office. Castillo Dominguez agreed to Cease and Desist from violations of Chapter 517, Florida Statutes, and the Administrative Rules adopted thereto, and to pay an administrative fine in the amount of \$4,375. The Office agreed to approve Castillo Dominguez's application as an associated person (RA) with Apella Capital, LLC effective March 29, 2024.

**Broker Statement**

Questions 14.D.(1)(b) and 14.D.(1)(d): In 2021, I relocated from California to Florida when while employed as an investment advisor at Inspired Financial (IARD: CRD # 125713/SEC#:801-79055) ("Inspired"), which reflected registration with the SEC, California and Pennsylvania. Prior to my relocation, I discussed with Inspired's chief compliance officer whether registration with the state of Florida was needed, and I was advised that registration with the state of Florida was not required. In 2023, Inspired Financial was acquired by Apella Wealth. Upon joining the new firm in July 2023, Apella Wealth submitted an application to the Office of Financial Regulation in the state of Florida to register me as an investment advisor. The Office made us aware that registration with the state of Florida was required. I detrimentally relied on Inspired's chief compliance officer at the time and did not pursue registration with the Office of Financial Regulation of the state of Florida at the time of my relocation. As soon as I was notified of this error, I ceased my activity and I collaborated with the Office to correct this administrative mistake.
