IAPD Information About Representatives

IAPD offers information on all current-and many former representatives. Investors are strongly encouraged to use IAPD to check the background of representatives before deciding to conduct, or continue to conduct, business with them.

What is included in a IAPD report?

IAPD reports for individual representatives include information such as employment history, professional qualifications, disciplinary actions, criminal convictions, civil judgments and arbitration awards.

It is important to note that the information contained in an IAPD report may include pending actions or allegations that may be contested, unresolved or unproven. In the end, these actions or allegations may be resolved in favor of the representative, or concluded through a negotiated settlement with no admission or finding of wrongdoing.

Where did this information come from?

The information contained in IAPD comes from the Investment Adviser Registration Depository (IARD) and FINRA's Central Registration Depository, or CRD, (see more on CRD below) and is a combination of:

- information the states require representatives and firms to submit as part of the registration and licensing process, and
- information that state regulators report regarding disciplinary actions or allegations against representatives.

Generally, representatives are required to update their professional and disciplinary information in IARD within 30 days.

Regulator Statement

The Securities Division alleged that the Respondents engaged in block trading and engaged in preferential allocation of those trades to favored accounts. The Securities Division alleged that the Respondents violated rules that apply to registered investment advisers and investment adviser representatives by failing to maintain required books and records, failing to disclose material information regarding the termination of its custodian, and failing to update the firm's Form ADV in a timely manner. In the Consent Order, the Respondents neither admit nor deny the Securities Division's Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, but agreed to cease and desist from violating the investment adviser rules. The Respondents each paid a fine of \$10,000 and reimbursed the Securities Division \$5,000 for its costs of investigation.
