IAPD Information About Representatives

IAPD offers information on all current-and many former representatives. Investors are strongly encouraged to use IAPD to check the background of representatives before deciding to conduct, or continue to conduct, business with them.

What is included in a IAPD report?

IAPD reports for individual representatives include information such as employment history, professional qualifications, disciplinary actions, criminal convictions, civil judgments and arbitration awards.

It is important to note that the information contained in an IAPD report may include pending actions or allegations that may be contested, unresolved or unproven. In the end, these actions or allegations may be resolved in favor of the representative, or concluded through a negotiated settlement with no admission or finding of wrongdoing.

Where did this information come from?

The information contained in IAPD comes from the Investment Adviser Registration Depository (IARD) and FINRA's Central Registration Depository, or CRD, (see more on CRD below) and is a combination of:

- information the states require representatives and firms to submit as part of the registration and licensing process, and
- information that state regulators report regarding disciplinary actions or allegations against representatives.

Generally, representatives are required to update their professional and disciplinary information in IARD within 30 days.

Broker Statement

[REDACTED] is a real estate agent who in 2023 was making \$220K/year. She wanted a product that would secure her retirement funding, as she is independent and had no access to a traditional 401k etc. She never intended to withdrawal funds prior to 59.5 and was very aware of surrender charges for 7yrs after opening the account. Her goal was to contribute as much as possible while her income was high. I left Thrivent about 6months after writing the business and in her own words "want to move the money to my new advisor with XX company, as I have not connected with a new rep at Thrivent". She requested the surrender charge of \$16865.46 be waived to do this. Thrivent dismissed her claim, as her new rep tried to contact her numerous times and my notes clearly explained the product and potential penalties. No claims were ever paid out and as far as I know [REDACTED] never canceled the product.
