IAPD Information About Representatives

IAPD offers information on all current-and many former representatives. Investors are strongly encouraged to use IAPD to check the background of representatives before deciding to conduct, or continue to conduct, business with them.

What is included in a IAPD report?

IAPD reports for individual representatives include information such as employment history, professional qualifications, disciplinary actions, criminal convictions, civil judgments and arbitration awards.

It is important to note that the information contained in an IAPD report may include pending actions or allegations that may be contested, unresolved or unproven. In the end, these actions or allegations may be resolved in favor of the representative, or concluded through a negotiated settlement with no admission or finding of wrongdoing.

Where did this information come from?

The information contained in IAPD comes from the Investment Adviser Registration Depository (IARD) and FINRA's Central Registration Depository, or CRD, (see more on CRD below) and is a combination of:

- information the states require representatives and firms to submit as part of the registration and licensing process, and
- information that state regulators report regarding disciplinary actions or allegations against representatives.

Generally, representatives are required to update their professional and disciplinary information in IARD within 30 days.

Broker Statement	<p>Mr. Payne and Morgan Stanley deny Claimant's allegations in the claim, and contend that all covered call option positions recommended to Claimant were suitable. Mr. Payne and Morgan Stanley contend that the market conditions associated with the pandemic, including the volatility and the rapid appreciation of the underlying stock's position from 2020-2021 adversely affected the performance of Claimant's options. They further contend that Claimant was appropriately advised of the risks associated with the options strategy and chose to continue the strategy despite its losses. Morgan Stanley settled the claim to avoid the costs and uncertainty of litigation. Mr. Payne was not asked to contribute to the settlement.</p>
