FA INDICATES THAT THE CLIENT INDICATED DURING THE PHONE CONVERSATION THAT HE WAS CONSIDERING TRANSFERRING HIS ANNUITY TO MIDLAND NATIONAL. PUTNAM ALLSTATE INDICATED THE CLIENT ELECTED THE RETIREMENT INCOME GUARANTEE AND ENHANCED BENEFICIARY PROTECTION RIDERS ADDED TO HIS CONTRACT. MR. INGLE STATED HE EXPLAINED THE ADDITIONAL FEES ASSOCIATED WITH THESE RIDERS AND THE FEATURES OF BOTH. PAGES 32 AND 35 OF THE PROSPECTUS EXPLAIN THE TERMS UNDER WHICH THE TWO RIDERS ARE EXECUTED AND DETERMINED. THE RIDERS ON THIS CONTRACT ARE NOT SUBJECT TO CHANGE AT THE COMPANY'S DISCRETION. MR. INGLE ALSO EXPLAINED HE MISSTATED THE WAITING PERIOD OF THE PAYOUT START DATE FOR INCOME PAYMENTS AS 5 YEARS, BUT HE ADVISED THE CLIENT SOON AFTER IT WAS A 10 YEAR WAITING PERIOD. PLEASE SEE PAGE 28 IN THE CURRENT PROSPECTUS FOR MORE DETAIL. IT IS MY UNDERSTANDING THE CLIENT'S CONCERN IN HIS LETTER ABOUT THE GUARANTEED RATE OF RETURN REFERS TO THE FIXED ACCOUNT OPTION IN THE CONTRACT. THE FIXED ACCOUNT OPTION IS SEPARATE FROM THE DEATH BENEFIT, RETIREMENT INCOME GUARANTEE RIDER 2, OR THE ENHANCED BENEFICIARY PROTECTION OPTION. THE STANDARD FIXED ACCOUNT OPTION AT THIS TIME IS PAYING 3% ANNUALLY CAN BE SET FOR A GUARANTEE PERIOD OF 1, 5, OR 7 YEARS. ALTHOUGH CURRENTLY AVAILABLE, PUTNAM ALLSTATE CAN DISCONTINUE THIS OPTION AT ITS DISCRETION; HOWEVER, THIS OPTION IS NOT A RIDER AND DOES NOT AFFECT THE RIDERS CURRENTLY IN PLACE ON THE CLIENT'S CONTRACT. CLAIM DENIED.
