IAPD Information About Representatives

What is included in a IAPD report?

THE UNDERSIGNED ARBITRATORS HAVE DECIDED AND DETERMINED IN FULL AND FINAL SETTLEMENT OF ALL CLAIMS BETWEEN THE PARTIES THAT: (1) DEFENDANTS' MOTION TO DISMISS BASED ON THE STATUTE OF LIMITATIONS IS DENIED. (2) CLAIMANTS' MOTION TO AMEND THE PLEADINGS TO CONFORM TO THE EVIDENCE IS DENIED. Broker Statement

SETTLEMENTS WERE REACHED WITH 17 OF THE 27 CLAIMANTS DISMISSING ALL CLAIMS AGAINST MS. BLANDON FOR AN AGGREGATE AMOUNT OF \$1,353,500. AN AWARD WAS ENTERED ON BEHALF OF THE REMAINING 10 CLAIMANTS IN THE AGGREGATE AMOUNT OF \$2,538,520 AGAINST PSI, MS. BLANDON AND OTHERS, JOINTLY AND SEVERALLY. ONE ARBITRATOR DISSENTED. AFTER NEGOTIATIONS BETWEEN THE PARTIES REGARDING RESOLUTION OF VARIOUS ASSERTIONS OF ARBITRATOR BIAS AND MISCONDUCT TERMINATED UNSUCCESSFULLY, CLAIMANTS AND RESPONDENTS (INCLUDING MS. BLANDON) BOTH PETITIONED THE FEDERAL COURT IN FLORIDA TO VACATE OF AMEND THE AWARD. BOTH MOTIONS WERE DENIED IN JULY 1996, AND PSI PAID THE ARBITRATION CLAIMANTS AND CERTAIN FAMILY MEMBERS WHO HAD FILED A SEPARATE ARBITRATION AN AGGREGATE OF \$4,164,483.37 WHICH INCLUDED INTEREST ON THE AWARD FROM 2/2/94 TO 7/31/96.
