IAPD Information About Representatives

IAPD offers information on all current-and many former representatives. Investors are strongly encouraged to use IAPD to check the background of representatives before deciding to conduct, or continue to conduct, business with them.

What is included in a IAPD report?

IAPD reports for individual representatives include information such as employment history, professional qualifications, disciplinary actions, criminal convictions, civil judgments and arbitration awards.

It is important to note that the information contained in an IAPD report may include pending actions or allegations that may be contested, unresolved or unproven. In the end, these actions or allegations may be resolved in favor of the representative, or concluded through a negotiated settlement with no admission or finding of wrongdoing.

Where did this information come from?

The information contained in IAPD comes from the Investment Adviser Registration Depository (IARD) and FINRA's Central Registration Depository, or CRD, (see more on CRD below) and is a combination of:

- information the states require representatives and firms to submit as part of the registration and licensing process, and
- information that state regulators report regarding disciplinary actions or allegations against representatives.

How current is this information?

Generally, representatives are required to update their professional and disciplinary information in IARD within 30 days.

Broker Statement	<p>"In August of 2016, Alex Craner was attending college at Arizona State University. He and his roommates had come into possession of "copied" parking passes. Unbeknownst to Alex, one of his roommates had been attempting to sell these copied passes to other students.</p> <p>Alex was subsequently arrested and charged as a result of these "copied" unauthorized parking passes. The charges and misdemeanor conviction were later set aside of the judgment of guilt, dismissing the complaint, information, or indictment, and that the applicant be released from all penalties and disabilities resulting from the conviction.</p> <p>This whole incident was simply the result of the unauthorized use of an illegitimate parking pass.</p> <p>The defense counsel and the prosecutor's office both commented that this case was a very minor offense that should have never been in the courts to begin with. This should have been handled in the campus traffic court for a parking violation. It should also be noted that Alex Craner has never been in court or charged with any other crime or violation in his entire life. (Not even parking tickets, speeding tickets, or any other traffic violation).</p> <p>Alex complied with all requirements of the court as a result of this case. The case was later "set aside" as noted above."</p>
