IAPD Information About Representatives

IAPD offers information on all current-and many former representatives. Investors are strongly encouraged to use IAPD to check the background of representatives before deciding to conduct, or continue to conduct, business with them.

What is included in a IAPD report?

IAPD reports for individual representatives include information such as employment history, professional qualifications, disciplinary actions, criminal convictions, civil judgments and arbitration awards.

It is important to note that the information contained in an IAPD report may include pending actions or allegations that may be contested, unresolved or unproven. In the end, these actions or allegations may be resolved in favor of the representative, or concluded through a negotiated settlement with no admission or finding of wrongdoing.

Where did this information come from?

The information contained in IAPD comes from the Investment Adviser Registration Depository (IARD) and FINRA's Central Registration Depository, or CRD, (see more on CRD below) and is a combination of:

- information the states require representatives and firms to submit as part of the registration and licensing process, and
- information that state regulators report regarding disciplinary actions or allegations against representatives.

How current is this information?

Generally, representatives are required to update their professional and disciplinary information in IARD within 30 days.

Broker Statement

Regarding the Charges I am going off the court document and the detail for what a Misdemeanor is as I do not recall specifically.

I was 19 at the time and it was 28 years ago so I may not remember all the details vividly. From what I do remember, I was driving around with a High School buddy and we ran into an acquaintance of his outside a garage and he asked if he could store some computers in my car for a couple days. The next day my buddy called and said his acquaintance wanted me to meet him with the computers, when I arrived there was another gentleman there who looked them over, the two of them walked away and had a conversation that I was not a part of and a few minutes later the buddy's acquaintance said I could go. Sometime later the police were in my driveway asking about the computers. To which I described the events that transpired and gave them the computers and the names of the other individuals. I could not afford a private attorney because I was 19 and just out of High School. My public defender advised me to plead guilty and I took that advice. In retrospect, I should have sought better legal counsel to advocate on my behalf. I was convicted of Receiving Stolen Property and paid a find of \$500.00 plus miscellaneous fines of \$83.33 and \$73.47 amounting to \$656.80 per the court document - Financial Information.
