## IAPD Information About Representatives

IAPD offers information on all current-and many former representatives. Investors are strongly encouraged to use IAPD to check the background of representatives before deciding to conduct, or continue to conduct, business with them.

### What is included in a IAPD report?

**Broker Statement**  
Around 2016-2018, a loan was taken out to purchase a car. The car cost around \$30,000. During the post-Pandemic aftermath, a situation occurred where payments towards the loan were not being made. Thus, a towing company came and took the car. At the time of initial reporting, the creditor (Tri-Color Auto) for the auto-dealer (Ganasauto) had not made contact regarding this repossession. As of



03/2023, there has been no further contact from the creditor or auto dealer, no court action, and no changes to the terms of the compromise (car repossessed to satisfy \$30,000) loan.
