IAPD Information About Representatives

IAPD offers information on all current-and many former representatives. Investors are strongly encouraged to use IAPD to check the background of representatives before deciding to conduct, or continue to conduct, business with them.

What is included in a IAPD report?

IAPD reports for individual representatives include information such as employment history, professional qualifications, disciplinary actions, criminal convictions, civil judgments and arbitration awards.

It is important to note that the information contained in an IAPD report may include pending actions or allegations that may be contested, unresolved or unproven. In the end, these actions or allegations may be resolved in favor of the representative, or concluded through a negotiated settlement with no admission or finding of wrongdoing.

Where did this information come from?

The information contained in IAPD comes from the Investment Adviser Registration Depository (IARD) and FINRA's Central Registration Depository, or CRD, (see more on CRD below) and is a combination of:

- information the states require representatives and firms to submit as part of the registration and licensing process, and
- information that state regulators report regarding disciplinary actions or allegations against representatives.

How current is this information?

Generally, representatives are required to update their professional and disciplinary information in IARD within 30 days.

 - A "settled" matter generally represents a disposition wherein the parties involved in a dispute reach an agreement to resolve the matter. Please note that Investment Adviser Representatives and firms may choose to settle customer disputes or regulatory matters for business or other reasons.

I was let go as the assistant branch manager at a Huntington Branch located in Grandville, Michigan in December of 2019. The manager that hired me instructed myself, the bankers, and our teller on staff to assign various checking and savings accounts, home equity lines of credit, mortgages, etc., in the name of the manager present in the office. She justified this reasoning by saying this was Huntington's way of incentivizing managers to help with whichever banking product the customer needed. She said due to the high turnover ratio of bankers in the industry, senior management wanted greater participation in sales with assistant branch managers and branch managers to ensure a better customer experience and the correct product recommendation based upon the customer's specific financial goals and needs. As a naïve 21 year-old, I trusted my manager.

Later in 2019, there was an investigation that took place amongst every member of our team of 6. I was told that the explanation I gave to human resources aligned with everyone on the team, regarding this was my manager's instruction to our team. My manager was let go after further evidence that this was her way of collecting additional money from sales. I was consequently let go because I did not verify this instruction with the district manager. Even though I was still the assistant branch manager, I was held partially responsible because I was paid a few hundred dollars on commission that was not originated by me, even though my manager instructed this to take place.
