IAPD Information About Representatives

IAPD offers information on all current-and many former representatives. Investors are strongly encouraged to use IAPD to check the background of representatives before deciding to conduct, or continue to conduct, business with them.

What is included in a IAPD report?

IAPD reports for individual representatives include information such as employment history, professional qualifications, disciplinary actions, criminal convictions, civil judgments and arbitration awards.

It is important to note that the information contained in an IAPD report may include pending actions or allegations that may be contested, unresolved or unproven. In the end, these actions or allegations may be resolved in favor of the representative, or concluded through a negotiated settlement with no admission or finding of wrongdoing.

Where did this information come from?

The information contained in IAPD comes from the Investment Adviser Registration Depository (IARD) and FINRA's Central Registration Depository, or CRD, (see more on CRD below) and is a combination of:

- information the states require representatives and firms to submit as part of the registration and licensing process, and
- information that state regulators report regarding disciplinary actions or allegations against representatives.

How current is this information?

Generally, representatives are required to update their professional and disciplinary information in IARD within 30 days.

Broker Statement

As far as I recall, this was an account that went to collections 8+ years ago, and I settled it with the collection company that reached out to me with the promise that they would remove it from my credit report after it was settled. It appeared that that account had been removed because my credit score went up. Then, years later (2019), the account showed back up on my credit report as a new collection account. I believe my father (who has the same name as me) paid the new settlement again when it came, thinking it was his and just paid it with his other bills. When I found out he had done that, I explained that I had already paid that and he didn't have to do it, but it was done. A couple of years later (2023), when going through by Prudential background check, I was made aware that the collection was still showing on my account after supposedly having been settled



twice now. This account is old and not a debt that was created within the past 8+ years. I am currently in the process of having it removed from my report. My score has recovered a little bit already and as far as I have been told, the collection account will be completely removed from my report within the next few months. I certainly hope my memory is accurate here, but I have not had any credit accounts, other than the 3 open accounts I currently have, for at least the past 6 years. The was an old, reappearing collection account that was settled for around \$600-\$800 which was less than the original amount of \$2,684.
