IAPD Information About Representatives

IAPD offers information on all current-and many former representatives. Investors are strongly encouraged to use IAPD to check the background of representatives before deciding to conduct, or continue to conduct, business with them.

What is included in a IAPD report?

IAPD reports for individual representatives include information such as employment history, professional qualifications, disciplinary actions, criminal convictions, civil judgments and arbitration awards.

It is important to note that the information contained in an IAPD report may include pending actions or allegations that may be contested, unresolved or unproven. In the end, these actions or allegations may be resolved in favor of the representative, or concluded through a negotiated settlement with no admission or finding of wrongdoing.

Where did this information come from?

The information contained in IAPD comes from the Investment Adviser Registration Depository (IARD) and FINRA's Central Registration Depository, or CRD, (see more on CRD below) and is a combination of:

- information the states require representatives and firms to submit as part of the registration and licensing process, and
- information that state regulators report regarding disciplinary actions or allegations against representatives.

How current is this information?

Generally, representatives are required to update their professional and disciplinary information in IARD within 30 days.

Sentence/Penalty: 545 days in the Indiana Department of Corrections, 10 days executed, 535 days suspended. Defendant has 10 days credit for the 5 days already served (4/2/2022-4/6/2022). Court costs of \$185.50 and \$200.00 alcohol countermeasures fee are imposed. Court recommends to the BMV that Defendant's license be suspended for 365 days beginning November 15, 2022. After 180 days without any violations, the suspension shall be stayed and SDP with a Certified Ignition Interlock Device shall be granted in a separate order. Probation for 365 days, with all standard terms and conditions, subject to those the Court may impose, including 1) payment of court costs, fines, and fees; 2) have a CARE or equivalent drug/alcohol assessment and comply with any treatment recommendations (including payment of the \$150.00 CARE fee); and 3) the defendant shall not consume or possess alcoholic beverages and shall not be on the premises of any establishment that sells or serves alcoholic beverages where a minor would not be allowed by law. Defendant is ordered to report in person to the Probation Department immediately after the Sentencing Hearing and payment of fines and costs are stayed for 90 days. Start Date of Penalty 11/15/2022. End Date of Penalty 11/14/2023. Monetary penalty/fine paid: \$680.00 paid 2/15/2023; \$275.00 paid 2/16/2023; and \$88.00 paid 3/2/2024 (Paid in Full)

Broker Statement I had a pervious misdemeanor OWI in 2021 which elevated the charges for this second offense. I took responsibility for my actions and plead guilty. As a result of this conviction, I quit drinking alcohol and have not had any for the past approximately 3.5 years. I voluntarily attended an outpatient program and AA on my own and completed probation with no issues. Additionally I have had no



subsequent legal issues and have truly learned my lesson.
