IAPD Information About Representatives

IAPD offers information on all current-and many former representatives. Investors are strongly encouraged to use IAPD to check the background of representatives before deciding to conduct, or continue to conduct, business with them.

What is included in a IAPD report?

IAPD reports for individual representatives include information such as employment history, professional qualifications, disciplinary actions, criminal convictions, civil judgments and arbitration awards.

It is important to note that the information contained in an IAPD report may include pending actions or allegations that may be contested, unresolved or unproven. In the end, these actions or allegations may be resolved in favor of the representative, or concluded through a negotiated settlement with no admission or finding of wrongdoing.

Where did this information come from?

The information contained in IAPD comes from the Investment Adviser Registration Depository (IARD) and FINRA's Central Registration Depository, or CRD, (see more on CRD below) and is a combination of:

- information the states require representatives and firms to submit as part of the registration and licensing process, and
- information that state regulators report regarding disciplinary actions or allegations against representatives.

How current is this information?

Generally, representatives are required to update their professional and disciplinary information in IARD within 30 days.

 - A "resolved" matter usually includes a disposition wherein no payment is made to the customer or there is no finding of wrongdoing on the part of the Investment Adviser Representative. Such matters generally involve customer disputes.

Exact end date of probation unknown as Clerk of Court was unable to retrieve exact records due to extended period of time that had passed since crime took place (10+ years). No monetary penalty/fine. |
| Broker Statement | I was arrested for Theft (less than \$500) and Theft by Fraud (less than \$500). This arrest stemmed from a substance abuse problem. I took a pair of earrings belonging to my grandmother, and I pawned them for \$75.00. My mother had me arrested as a measure to make me see the severity of my substance abuse, and the toll it was taking on my family. After I was arrested, my mother attempted to have the charges dropped since I did agree to seek treatment for my issues, and I immediately took action to buy back the earrings and return them to my grandmother. The district attorney would not allow the both charges to be dropped, but he allowed me to make a deal. I was instructed to successfully complete inpatient treatment, submit to random drug testing, and complete 2 years of supervised probation, and in return, he would dismiss the theft charge if I pled guilty to the theft by fraud charge. The theft charge was dismissed on 02/28/2012, and I successfully completed 2 years of supervised probation in early 2014. |
